Dear Ms. Balkavich:

Since the Bellwood-Antis Farm Show didn't operate for the 2012 fair season, the fair is in its second year of suspension.

Under the Pennsylvania Agricultural Fair Act, 3 P.S §§ 1501-1508 (the "Act") and the regulations issued thereunder at 7 Pa. Code Chapter 102, an eligible organization that resumes annual exhibitions that have been temporarily discontinued for a period of not more than two years will remain eligible for funds under the Act.

If the Bellwood-Antis Farm Show doesn't conduct a fair for 2013, you will be required to reapply as a probationary organization to the Department of Agriculture in a letter addressed to the Secretary. The applicant will be required to conduct three annual exhibitions before being entitled to funds, pursuant to section 6(b) of the Act and section 102.24 of the regulations.

We wish you well with your endeavors.
