# Hunter Over Fences

Each horse will individually negotiate a course consisting of at least 8 jumps over a minimum of 4 different obstacles. At least one change of direction is recommended. The hunter should provide his rider with a safe, consistent ride at a working pace over a course of fences similar to those that might be encountered in the field. This requires that all horses must be serviceably sound and any horse showing evidence of lameness, broken wind or impairment of vision will be excused from the ring by the steward, show vet or judge.

# Western Trail

Horses will negotiate obstacles with style and consistency. Credit will be given to horses that show the capability of picking their way through the course when obstacles warrant it, and willingly respond to the rider's cues on more difficult obstacles. Horses with artificial appearance over obstacles will be penalized. The course must be designed to show appropriate gait differences (walk, jog/trot, lope/canter, halt, back). A minimum of 6 obstacles will be used. Time in excess of 30 seconds or 3 attempts in approaching an obstacle will eliminate the score for the obstacle and the rider will proceed to the next obstacle. The class will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and attitude. This class may be ridden in either English or Western tack or attire but not a combination of both.

# In Hand Jumping

Judge(s) shall walk Hunter/Jumper course with designer and exhibitors. Course diagrams must show with arrows the direction each obstacle must be taken. A start and finish line must be established. Horses (exhibitors optional) must cross the line in the proper direction to start and complete the course. Horses must stay within the course boundaries as outlined by the start and finish cone. Baiting of horses to encourage an animal to perform any of the jumps is not allowed. Baiting in such class is a disqualification.

Jumpers are scored mathematically, based on faults incurred between the starting line and the finishing line. Exhibitors may go over jumps with horse. Whips are not permitted in show ring. Circling once upon entering the ring and once upon leaving the ring is permissible, but not after crossing starting line. SCORING jumpers: an in and out is to be considered as two (2) jumps. Jumpers are to be scored on a mathematical basis and penalty faults include knockdowns, refusals, and eliminations
