

Bridle Path Hack

All horses will enter the ring in a counter-clockwise direction at a trot until otherwise directed by the judge. Horses are to be shown at the walk, trot, extended trot, canter and hand gallop (Hand gallop will occur in groups of no more than 10). At the hand gallop horses may be asked as a group to halt and stand on a loose rein. May be asked to back readily and walk off on a loose rein. Excessive speed at the hand gallop will be penalized.

It is recommended that all judges establish in advance what is to be considered a fault. This class may be divided into sections for minis, ponies, horses or drafts as show management wishes. English Trail

Horses will negotiate obstacles with style and consistency. Credit will be given to horses that show the capability of picking their way through the course when obstacles warrant it, and willingly respond to the rider's cues on more difficult obstacles. Horses with artificial appearance over obstacles will be penalized. The course must be designed to show appropriate gait differences (walk, jog/trot, lope/canter, halt, back). A minimum of 6 obstacles will be used. Time in excess of 30 seconds or 3 attempts in approaching an obstacle will eliminate the score for the obstacle and the rider will proceed to the next obstacle. The class will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and attitude. This class may be ridden in either English or Western tack or attire but not a combination of both.

Hunter Over Fences

Each horse will individually negotiate a course consisting of at least 8 jumps over a minimum of 4 different obstacles. At least one change of direction is recommended. The hunter should provide his rider with a safe, consistent ride at a working pace over a course of fences similar to those that might be encountered in the field. This requires that all horses must be serviceably sound and any horse showing evidence of lameness, broken wind or impairment of vision will be excused from the ring by the steward, show vet or judge.

Entries will be asked to follow given commands on the rail both ways of the ring that may include walking, trotting, stopping, backing and turning at any gait. Handlers and equine will also be asked to execute a pattern. Patterns may include any of the above gaits as well as ground tying. Equines and handlers will be judged 70% on suitability as a team in communication and execution of rail work, 15% on pattern completion and 15% on presentation of both handler and equine.

Western Trail

Horses will negotiate obstacles with style and consistency. Credit will be given to horses that show the capability of picking their way through the course when obstacles warrant it, and willingly respond to the rider's cues on more difficult obstacles. Horses with artificial appearance over obstacles will be penalized. The course must be designed to show appropriate gait differences (walk, jog/trot, lope/canter, halt, back). A minimum of 6 obstacles will be used. Time in excess of 30 seconds or 3 attempts in approaching an obstacle will eliminate the score for the obstacle and the rider will proceed to the next obstacle. The class will be judged on the performance of the horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and attitude. This class may be ridden in either English or Western tack or attire but not a combination of both.
