### Entries are due online by July 25th.

To place an online entry, go to: http://nwwafair.fairwire.com/

#### Exhibits will be due in the Farm Pavilion Monday July 31st from 3 pm to 7 pm.

If you cannot enter online, you may still enter your items on the entry drop off date.

#### Exhibits and ribbons can be picked up the Sunday following the end of the fair from 12 pm to 2 pm

- Entries must be brought to the Farm Pavilion Monday July 31<sup>st</sup>, 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Online entries still require you to bring your item in at the day and time listed for this department. Online entries do not guarantee a spot if the space is full when you bring your item in.
- Only one entry per class. Each class has potential for two premiums only.
- All entries will be judged on general appearance, beauty of design, workmanship and suitability. The opinion of the judge must be final in all cases. Qualified judges are from outside of Whatcom County.
- No premium will be given unless the article is worthy, regardless of competition.
- Any needlework item completed since August of the previous year and not previously shown at the Northwest Washington Fair is eligible.
- All articles must be the handiwork of the exhibitor. Articles that are soiled will not be accepted. No items with glass will be accepted. Superintendent has the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- Department, division and class is determined by the exhibitor. If you have questions about your entry, please contact the superintendent prior to entry day.
- Please use the description space for online entries and give brief description of item, such as color, pattern, etc.
- Entries must be picked up on Sunday after the fair between 12 p.m. and 2 p.m. There is NO SECURITY available after Sunday release time and on Monday the buildings will remain open for cleaning.
- No entry fees are required, and no free admission will be issued to exhibitors.
- Doilies, afghans, knitted and crocheted pieces must be blocked. All items should lay flat for judging.
- A MANDATORY hanging sleeve is required for all quilts and wall hangings. Sleeves must be:
  - o Sewn, not pinned, to the back-top edge of your entry
  - 4-inch or 5-inch finished tube
  - Run the full width of your entry
  - Quilts and wall hangings without sleeves will not be accepted because they cannot be displayed. If you need information about making and sewing on your hanging sleeve, you can find help on the internet by searching for "quilt hanging sleeves". Most quilt shops can assist you with this also.
- All quilts and wall hangings will be displayed by hanging them on rods. The rods used are mostly galvanized plumbing pipes. It is recommended that your hanging sleeve is a 4" or 5" finished TUBE. That way, your entry will not come in contact with the pipe. If your sleeve is not a tube, then the back of your entry will contact the pipe and may become soiled.
- Every attempt is made to fully display all quilt and wall hanging entries; however, it is not always possible due to the volume of entries, and in that case, some entries may be partially displayed. The decision to partially display an entry is based on space available and how each entry will fit into the available spaces.
