General Rules for Crocheting

- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2024.
- Limit one entry per class per exhibitor.
- Entry is free if pre-entered online or by form in the Fair office by 12 PM, August 1. Exhibits registered during entry are subject to a \$1 fee per entry.
- 17 & Under enter youth divisions 0990, 0991, and 0992.
- The judges reserve the option to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.
- Quality or brand of yarn will not be judged.

WHAT THE JUDGES LOOK FOR WITH CROCHETING

- <u>General Appearance</u>: Visual impact, presentation, clean, neat & well blocked
- <u>Suitability of Design, Color & Yarn</u>: Choice of yarn & trim type & color appropriate to pattern & function
- <u>Workmanship</u>: Stitches made correctly, uniform tension, correct gauge, no dropped stitches, blocked as needed, yarn ends joined & woven inconspicuously, construction details well executed, carried yarns neat and not too tight
- Difficulty of Project

What the Judges look for in Tatting

- <u>Appearance & Overall Effect</u>: Design selection & presentation, thread compatibility, use of color (if applicable)
- <u>Workmanship & Technical Skills</u>: Proper tension, neatness, finishing
- Difficulty Factor

RUGS & MISCELLANEOUS HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

What the Judge looks for in Rugs

- <u>General Appearance</u>: Neat & clean
- <u>Workmanship</u>: stitches correct, tension even, finishing techniques correct & neat
- <u>Suitability of Design, Color, Thread</u>: Choice of thread type and color appropriate to pattern & function, finishing techniques appropriate, choice of background fabric type & color appropriate to pattern & function
- Difficulty of Project

- 97 Hooked or latch hooked item, any article, specify item

NOVICE CROCHETING

Division 0975 (Adults 18+)

NOVICE CROCHETER

- "Novice" refers to anyone who is just starting out in crocheting.
- Exhibitor can enter in this or any other section in this department.
- Anyone who has entered in prior Fairs in this or any other section is not considered a novice and should not enter in this section.
- Any technique can be used.


