ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: AUGUST 16 (After 8/16 late fees will apply.)
- Required forms: Hold Harmless Waiver, PT. All turkeys entering Washington State for exhibition must originate from an NPIP participant flock that has met Pullorum-Typhoid, Avian Influenza, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and Mycoplasma synoviae classification requirements or has tested negative for Pullorum-Typhoid, Avian Influenza, Mycoplasma gallisepticum and Mycoplasma synoviae within 30 days of shipment
- ALL EXHIBITORS MUST PURCHASE AN EXHIBITOR'S PASS
- VET CHECK-IN WEDNESDAY from 11:00 am-12:00 pm ONLY
- Mandatory poultry departments meeting at 12:30 on Wednesday.
- Maximum of five (5) birds per exhibitor.
- All exhibitors must enter Herdsmanship and barn decorations.
- No Cross Entries within the 4-H Department
- Read Livestock handbook and General Rules & Regulations.

OPEN POUTRY RULES

- Kittitas County will not be responsible for loss or accident
- 2. The superintendent will remove any fowl which shows sign of disease.
- All exhibitors must sign a waiver recognizing the possibility of New Castle Disease, and releasing Kittitas County Fair and all other parties from liability.
- All birds must have been in the State of Washington for at least 6 months and in their present ownership for at least 45 days and be free of Avian Influenza. PT testing required
- 5. In filling out entry forms, the exhibitor is expected to state plainly the sex, age, breed, and variety and must show the proper Division and Class numbers.
- 6. Changes of poultry animal are only allowed up to one week before fair.
- 7. Trios or pens shall be entered separately. Fowl entered in single Division shall not compete in trio or pens.
- All exhibitors must enter the DIVISION 09-Q,
 Herdsmanship Contest, and participate in Barn Duty.
- 9. The exhibitor will provide the feeders and waterer.
- 10. The exhibitor is expected to properly feed, water, and clean his/her fowl BEFORE 8am, during and at the end of each Fair Day. The Superintendent may withhold premiums if the exhibitor fails to care for his/her exhibit.
- 11. Advertising and "FOR SALE" signs are not permitted.
- 12. Specify the breed, age of bird, and leg band number on the cage card.
- 13. All poultry will be judged by the American Poultry Association standards.
- 14. Pigeons and game birds will be judged at the discretion of the judge.
- 15. The exhibitor shall make every effort to be present when his/her exhibit is being judged.

- 16. No poultry will be accepted for exhibit prior to 11:00 am and no later than 12:00 pm on Wednesday.
- 17. The Superintendent may deny entry to any animal deemed unworthy of public display.
