General Rules for Quilting

- CHECK-IN DATE & JUDGING DATE! See above.
- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2024.
- Limit <u>one</u> entry per class per exhibitor.
- Entry is free if pre-entered online or by form in the Fair office by 12 PM, August 1. Exhibits registered during entry are subject to a \$1 fee per entry.
- 17 & Under enter youth divisions 1190, 1191, and 1192.
- No awards will be allowed for articles entered which have been purchased, received as a gift, or borrowed.
- All articles competing for premiums must be completed; otherwise, they will not be judged.
- The judges reserve the option to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.
- Each entry will be eligible for best of show.
- Definitions:
 - Mixed Media: combination of two or more techniques.
 - Novice: anyone who is just starting out in quilting.
 - Group quilt: three or more people

Special Awards

North Idaho Quilter's Award

The North Idaho Quilters Guild will award first place NIQ ribbon and \$20 cash prize, second place receives NIQ ribbon and \$10 cash prize to each of the following: Adult- Most Patriotic Quilt, Best use of hand embroidery or applique, Best use of machine embroidery or applique and Best Group Quilt. Youth- Best Overall Youth Quilt. Winners will be determined based on work on construction, use of color, design, and application of hand or machine quilting. Prize to be mailed after Fair.

Washington State Quilter's Award

The Washington State Quilters guild of Spokane, Washington will award a cash prize of \$25 and ribbon to the first-place winner and an additional ribbon for the second-place winner.

Quilts of any size, crib quilts or wall hangings in the Adult Open Division displaying best work in construction, use of color, design and

application of hand quilting or machine quilting stitches are eligible for this award. Whole cloth quilts are also included. **All quilts must be owned by the exhibitor**.

All quilts must be pieced/appliqued by the exhibitor. WSQ allows quilts machine or hand quilted by others to be eligible for this award. A quilt that is entered with all work completed by the exhibitor will given special consideration for this award.

What the Judges look for with Quilts

- General Appearance: Total impact, neat & clean, square & flat
- <u>Design</u>: Choice & use of color & pattern for top & borders, suitability of materials to design & function, originality or use of traditional pattern
- Workmanship: Precision of cutting, stitching & finishing, quilting techniques, binding & edging
