### **General Rules for General Crafts**

- Entries must be the work of the exhibitor, completed since September 2023.
- Limit one entry per class per exhibitor.
- Entry is free if pre-entered online or by form in the Fair office by 5 PM, August 2. Exhibits registered during entry are subject to a \$1 fee per entry.
- 17 & under enter youth divisions 13H, 13I, and 13J.
- Only completed items will be judged.
- Items made with plastic canvas must be entered in Department 13-General Crafts.
- No awards will be allowed for articles entered which have been purchased, received as a gift, or borrowed.
- Where there is no competition, or article has been incorrectly entered, judges may award first, second, third or nothing, according to the merits of the entry. Judges shall not award prizes to unworthy entries.
- The judges reserve the option to withhold ribbons and awards in a class where there is no deserving entry.
- Items should be entered on August 8-9, 2-7 PM as non-perishable entries.

### What the Judges look for with Crafts

- <u>General Appearance</u>: Neat, clean, well balanced, finishing techniques enhance finished item
- Workmanship: Consistent use of proper techniques, attention to detail, neatness of work (paint applied evenly & cleanly, no visible glue, etc.), balance of design & color, finishing techniques well done, workmanship appropriate to age of exhibitor.
- <u>Suitability</u> of <u>Design</u>, <u>Color</u>, <u>Construction</u> <u>Materials</u>:
   Originality/creativity of design, choice of materials, pleasing color combinations, type of materials appropriate to use of finished item
- Difficulty of Project

   What the Judges look for in Paper Tole/3D Decoupage
- Workmanship: Precision cutting. Each piece must be separated, shaped and reassembled. Creative and realistic shaping with no cracked edges; Nicely rounded and colored edges. All glue and other means of elevation hidden from view, no gaps visible.
- <u>Layers</u>: Background, middle ground, and foreground should be kept in perspective. The background should have less emphasis than the foreground.
- <u>Framing</u>: Free from debris inside the frame. Complementary mats and frames, with a professional looking finish.

### What the Judges look for in Models

- <u>Paint job</u>: Models will score higher with paint job than those without; decals should be neat; all parts of the car should be painted or chromed, except tires.
- Assembly: Lack of glue smears & paint blobs, parts fit, parts belong to model.
- <u>Feasibility</u>: If this model was full sized, could it be operated? Driveshaft should be connected to engine on car model.
- <u>Details</u>: Engine wiring, compartment detail, paint & chrome, underside of model cars should be painted.


