### HAY, GRAIN & FORAGE RULES

- 1. All products exhibited must have been grown in Kittitas County during the 2024 season.
- 2. Like products must be assembled at one place at the time of judging.
- 3. All sheaf displays of hay and grain must be in bundles, tied at three places and not less than three inches in diameter at the butt; leave all stems and leaves.
- 4. LIMIT: ONE ENTRY PER CLASS
- 5. Read General Rules & Regulations.

### Class 01 - Large Open Educational Display

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g., tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)

### **PREMIUM POINTS**

### Class 02 - Small Open Educational Display

Small Display: size allowed up to  $24'' \times 36''$  maximum (combined horizontal and vertical), down to  $11'' \times 17''$  minimum.
