#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Clubs and local barns will be given priority for stall assignments. The number of stalls per club or barn will be allocated by the Superintendent.
- 2. Haul-ins and outs are only at specified time.
- 3. Each horse/exhibitor combination must submit their own entry and have a number assigned to them. Exhibitor numbers cannot be shared. Premiums go to the number used.
- 4. All livestock eligible to compete in purebred classes must submit a copy of registration papers. Registration papers must be received or the horse, pony, or mini will be put in the open class.
- 5. The fair vet must and will reject any animal with an infectious disease or ectoparasites, including, but not limited to, ringworm, warts, pink eye, strangles, contagious exthyma, scabies, lice, mites, ticks, fleas, and all respiratory diseases. The veterinarian will determine the animal's soundness and fitness to compete at the Fair and decide whether to admit or reject any animal at his or her discretion. The decision of the Fair vet is final.

- 6. The Superintendent has the right to accept or refuse any entry.
- 7. 4H and FFA entries may cross-enter in Open.
- 8. Exhibitors must follow NWWF Open Light Horse Show Rules.
- 9. Any exhibitor under the age of 18 is not allowed to show a stallion of any breed.
- 10. **Helmet Rule:** All open class exhibitors in performance classes under the age of 18 are required to wear a helmet.
- 11. A Novice Rider/Handler Class is open to riders in their first or second year of showing. A Green Horse Class is open to horses in their first or second year of showing.
- 12. An Amateur is qualified as one who, after his/her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, has not engaged in any of the following activities which would make him/her a professional:
  - a. Accepts remuneration for riding, driving, showing in halter/in hand, training, schooling, or conducting clinics or seminars.
  - b. Accepts remuneration for giving instruction in equitation or horse training. Persons acting as counselors at summer camps or giving training to the handicapped are excluded.
  - c. Rides, drives, or shows in halter/in hand competitions, any horse for which he/she or a member of his/her family or a corporation which a member of his/her family controls, receives remuneration for boarding, training, riding, driving, or showing.
  - d. Gives instruction to any person or rides, drives, or shows in competitions any horse, for which activity another person in his/her family or corporation which a member of his/her family controls will receive remuneration for the activity.
  - e. Receiving monies from classes that offer scholarship bonds or premium monies from local fairs is exempt from consideration of Amateur status. See the USEF Rulebook for a complete listing of activities that do not affect the amateur status of a person.
- 13. No cross-entry is allowed between walk/jog and walk/jog/lope classes in the same division, with the exception of green horse classes. Green horses may enter walk/jog OR regular walk/jog/lope classes in addition to the green horse classes, but not both.
- 14. Classes with fewer than three entries may be canceled or combined. Large classes may be split at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- 15. Both registered and grade animals may compete for Grand and Reserve Grand Champion rosettes.
- 16. Competitors may be dismissed from a class by the judge for failure to follow directions, creating a hazard, or going off-course. These decisions are at the sole discretion of the judge and may not be contested.
- 17. Any interaction or interference with the judge by an exhibitor or an exhibitor's supporters or assistants will result in immediate disqualification of the exhibitor from further competition. Do not approach the judge at any time without first contacting the Superintendent about any issue or question you may have. Any interference with the Superintendent in the performance of her duties, in any manner, shall result in disqualification from further competition. Refusal to accept the awards made shall result in disqualification from further competition. Disqualification shall result in forfeiture of any premiums or ribbons already awarded.
- 18. All exhibitors are required to enter at least two (2) classes and participate in Herdsmanship.
- 19. Stalls and aisleways must be clean and tidied by 10 a.m. each day.
- 20. Decorations, drapes, and any other items attached to stalls are to remain up until 10 p.m. on Saturday or clubs and exhibitors will forfeit all premiums.
- 21. After the Horse Barn closes on Saturday exhibitors are responsible for cleaning their own stall(s) to the floor. This includes removing all duct tape, etc., that you have used in your stall area. Stalls may be pitched to the center aisle. Failure to clean up your stall area completely will result in a cleaning fee.
- 22. Animals will be excused after 10 p.m. Saturday. Exhibitors may haul out Saturday night or wait until Sunday. All animals must be removed from the fairgrounds by 1 p.m. Sunday.
