## ENTRY AND EXHIBITS

- Entry form deadline: Third Friday in August by 5pm.
- All viable fruits and vegetables are donated at the end of Fair to the Kittitas County Food Bank.
- Displayed in the 4-H Building
- Exhibits will be physically accepted in the 4-H building from 9:00 am -12:00 pm on Wednesday prior to Fair.
- Plates will be provided for fruits.

## FRUIT RULES

1. One entry per class.
2. Fruit for exhibit is judged according to size, quality, color, trueness to variety type, freedom from blemishes and uniformity. The best size should properly represent the variety and is of the size and shape normal for the variety. Quality should be of the highest. Fruit should be mature and should be free from blemishes of any kind. Fruits should retain their stems and must be as uniform as is possible to select. Color should be characteristic of the variety. Color may be brightened by polishing with a soft cloth. NO OIL or WAX should be used to polish the fruit.
3. Apples, Pears Peaches, Plums, Crab Apples, Grapes, Berries, and nuts shall be entered on standard paper plates.
4. All fruits and nuts must have been grown in Kittitas County.

- Display may include sound, motion, 3-D, etc.
- Use large lettering to convey the main message. All wording should be readable from 6 feet away.
- All content must be original and copyright free.


## Class 01 - Large Open Educational Display

Large Display: Maximum 20 square feet combined horizontal and vertical space (e.g., tri-fold display board on top of your own card table) down to 6 square feet (combined horizontal and vertical)
