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SWINE GENERAL RULES:

- 1. Animals will be shown by breed.
- 2. Limited to five animal entries per exhibitor, not limited to one entry per class. Contact the Competitive Exhibits Office to request permission for more entries.
- 3. Animals shown in market class will not be eligible for show in breeding classes.
- 4. Rosettes for Grand and Reserve awarded if deserving.
- 5. All tack, feed, etc. must be stored within allotted areas.
- 6. No pens may be separated or broke into smaller pens without permission from the Superintendent.
- 7. No weaned boars. Uncastrated piglets in Sow with Litter are accepted.
- 8. Barrows may be eligible to be entered in Market Hog classes.
- 9. Open Swine can be shown in 4-H or FFA. However, Open Swine cannot sell in the Lynden Jr. Livestock Sale without also being shown in 4-H or FFA which would mean being at Fair all 10 days.
- 10. Herdsmanship is required from 10 am to 9 pm daily. You may team up with another exhibitor(s).

DIVISION A- BREEDING SOWS

Be sure to include breed on entry form. Will be shown by breed. Example Breeds: Kunekune, Hampshire, Chester White, Berkshire, Idaho Pasture Pig, Duroc, Tamworth, American Guinea Hog, Landrace, Gloucestershire Old Spot, Yorkshire, and Crossbreeds.
