General Rules for Rabbits

- All rabbits must be identified by a permanent tattoo. Illegible tattoos may be disqualified at the judge's discretion.
- Exhibitors will be allowed in the barns to feed and clean between 7 and 9:30 AM each morning.
- Specimens that show symptoms of sickness will be removed from the exhibit building. Animals must be free from mites and ear canker to be entered.
- Rabbits entered in crossbred class need not be registered to enter as a purebred; however, rabbits entered in purebred class must conform to breed standards as set forth in the latest edition of the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
 - Rabbits must be entered into a breed class in order to be eligible to show in a fur class.
- Breed classes will be judged in accordance to the ARBA Breed Standards. Fur classes will be judged in accordance with ARBA General Fur Standards.
- The top showman of each department will represent their species in the final drive-round robin championship.
- All ARBA classes will be paid out for Best of Breed/Best Opposite Sex of Breed as well as Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.
 - Minimum 5 rabbits per breed required in order to receive premium payout.
- All Open Divisions will be paid out for 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- ARBA classes are open to all purebred rabbits. Only exhibitors that are ARBA members will receive ARBA points and legs. If not labeled ARBA, classes are open to all.
