Registration will be done through the Duval County Extension Office. Please call 904-255-7450 and ask for Gaye Schmidt or email Duval4h@ifas.ufl.edu. She will register team numbers and age divisions who intend to participate. You may also do walk-up registration the day of the contest.

This will help us have the correct awards for winning teams. At the conclusion of each contest, the **contest superviso**r will ask for the winners' names, addresses, and other pertinent information so that the awards can be distributed. This completed record will be given to the Livestock Secretary.

This contest will be for 4-H and F.F.A. teams to test their knowledge of Florida's Forests. Four contest stations enable youths to test their identification skills and knowledge of forest ecosystems. Youths will be asked to identify trees, plants, leaves, fruits, insects, and disease damage from samples, and answer multiple-choice questions on forest ecology.

A Forest Ecology Team shall consist of three (3) or four (4) bona fide 4-H Club/ F.F.A. Chapter members ages 8-18. The three highest scores from a four person team will be used in competition. It is strongly recommended that all contestants wear appropriate 4-H/F.F.A. attire.

AGE DIVISIONS

- 1. F.F.A. Junior Division will be Middle School students.
- 2. F.F.A. Senior Division will be Senior High students.
- 3. 4-H Junior Division: 8-10 yrs. as of Sept.1st of the current year
- 4. 4-H Intermediate Division: 11-13 yrs. as of Sept. 1st of the current year
- 5. 4-H Senior Division: 14-18 yrs. as of Sept. 1st of the current year

Clover buds (ages 5-7) are welcome to judge for practice and will be awarded a participation ribbon.
