- Completed forms must be submitted in the online portal (opening in April) on or before 6/15/2023. Failure to submit this card by June 15 at 11:59pm will make you ineligible to show your animal at the Dane County Fair.

- If showing in more than one species, youth must complete and submit the requirements for each species separately.
