The Bottom Line

The cost of a 4-H, FFA or Independent exhibitor's project animal is higher than that of commercially produced livestock due to the added initial costs of purchasing a stock show animal combined with the individual attention given to the animal's development. Junior members dedicate hundreds of hours caring for their project while learning valuable life skills along the way. The price paid above the breakeven cost will allow the exhibitors to earn a profit that can be reinvested into next year's project and/or saved for college funding. Exhibitors who participate in market animal and vocational education projects develop work ethic, responsibility, entrepreneurship experience, marketing skills and strategies, recordkeeping and financial management skills, accountability, leadership and teamwork. These economic and beneficial factors associated with the livestock project deserve a premium price.

Custom: The animal will be custom processed and packaged for you by the local service provider you select on your Buyer's Form. The local processor will contact you for cut & wrap instructions and to schedule pick-up of the product when ready. You will be financially responsible for the cut & wrap fee from the local processor.

Resale: The animal will be automatically resold for you at the current market price, which will be included in the sale booklet. You will not take possession of the product and are only financially responsible for paying the difference between your bid and the resale price.

Live Pick-up: As the winning bidder of a market animal lot, you have the option of choosing to "Live Pickup" your purchase(s). The animal must be picked up on Sunday, August 13, 2023 by 6 pm.

For Businesses: Present packaged meat to your customers, host a BBQ for employees, etc.

How to Participate in Person

Come to the fair and bid on August 12th or 13th. In your Buyer's Packet you will receive two tickets for entrance into the fair on Saturday, August 12th. Fair Admission is free for everyone on Sunday, August 13th. Upon entrance to the fair please proceed to the "Mobile J&C Auction Trailer" located across the walkway from the Sale Ring to check in with your completed/signed Buyer's Agreement and to receive your Buyer's Number.

Credit card payments in the form of VISA and MasterCard will be accepted with a **1.5% processing fee** on the day of the Auction. The full **3% processing fee** will be collected for any payments occurring after the day of the Auction.

If you don't want to buy an animal, but would still like to support the auction, we have the Price Support option. Price Support allows you to boost the price for an individual seller, a 4-H club or an FFA chapter. You can also boost the price of a certain species of animals by the pound, by a flat rate or all the animals under a certain price. Lastly, you can give money to support the auction in general.
