#### **RULES:**

- 1. Read Open Class Creative Living Rules and Boulder County General Rules and Regulations listed on the website.
- 2. Please note that there will be no monetary premiums for this show. Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> placing.
- 3. When filling out the entry form, Painting and Sculpture is Department 118.
- 4. If the item is for sale, attach a tag on the back of your artwork with information on how to contact you for the price, etc.
- 5. All work must be ORIGINAL works.
- 6. Artwork must be ready for display: dry, suitably framed, and sufficiently wired for hanging: no saw tooth hangers or bare glass edges.
  - a. Painted gallery-wrapped work is acceptable.
  - b. All sculptures should be sturdy and moveable with no loose parts and not dangerous for public display. You must provide an adequate pedestal.

- 7. Artwork deemed inappropriate for this family and public event may be prohibited from this exhibit. For example:
  - a. No Nudity
  - b. No Politics or Political Statements.
  - c. No Religion or Religious subjects.
  - d. No Violence.
- 8. Artwork will be turned away if it DOES NOT adhere to these rules.
- 9. All Art must have been created within the last 2 years.
- 10. This art exhibit is open to adults 18 and over.
- 11. Artwork may be moved into different categories at the superintendents' discretion for the exhibit's benefit.
- 12. SIZE LIMITATIONS: Artwork is to be no larger than 18" X 24" with frame, Sculpture size is to be no larger than 24"x 24" x 24" and weigh no more than 20lbs MAXIMUM. All sculptures need to provide their own pedestal.

# **EXHIBIT RELEASE:**

- A. Exhibits must be picked up between 4 6:00 PM on Monday, August 14, 2023.
- B. The artist is responsible for collecting their artwork or making arrangements to have them picked up.
- C. Exhibits left will be donated to charity.
- D. There will not be any premium money paid out this year. Only ribbons.

All artwork will be handled with care. Your submission of artwork for exhibit automatically waives any claim for damage or loss against the LONGMONT ARTISTS' GUILD, OR BOULDER COUNTY FAIR, its members, or its assigns.

Artwork will be entered under these categories:

- **1.** Paintings (oil, acrylic, pastel, watercolor, gouache, etc.)
- 2. Mixed Media & Assemblage
- **3.** Drawing (pen & ink, pencil, charcoal, colored pencil)
- **4.** Sculpture, 3D (with pedestal if needed)
