UPDATE FROM THE NATIONAL OFFICE:

Early check in will be Thursday June 29th and Friday June 30th Additional fees will apply. All contestants must be checked in no later than 3:00 PM on Saturday July 1st. If you are a day hauler you may check your horses in on Thursday or Friday. Upon arrival to the Lazy E you need to make sure you have all of your horse forms with you they can be printed off of the website. This includes Lazy E Arena Health Certificate, Vaccination and Coggins Policy. A current health certificate issued within 7 days and a 12-month coggins is required to enter The Lazy E facility. Additionally, all horses must have been vaccinated with an FDA-approved vaccine for EHV (Rhino) and Influenza not less than 14 days and not more than 60 days prior to date of entry. Once your horses are checked in you will proceed to the National Office where you will turn in the paperwork (signed by the check in crew) in order to pick up your packets and back numbers.

Please note a lot of the camping sites have been upgraded to 50 amp. Please see changes below: Don't forget your adapters if your trailer uses a 30 amp plug in.

Orange Lot (1-20 same as last year) 21-68 (50 amp)

Pink Lot 1-28 (same as last year) 29 – 76 (50 amp), 77-114 (same as last year)

Green Lot 1-18 (same as last year), 28-58 (50 amp)

Purple (same as last year)

Blue 1 – 90 (all 50 amp) 91-106 (30 amp no generator but still 30 amp spider boxes)

Teal/ Post Road, Lime, Rose, Red, Navy, Lilac, (all 50 amp)

Black, Gold, Gen Lot (no generators but still 30 amp spider boxes)

Forest Green: Generators and 30 amp spider boxes same as last year

White: 1-13 Generators and 50 amp spider boxes / 14-120 generators and 30 amp spider boxes same as last year.

You can put a deposit down for your camp spot for 2024 if your contestant is there and competing. We will only take name transfers if you are an aging out contestant and it is still only one camp site per contestant family. You can make those payments Sunday July 2nd through Saturday July 8th at noon. The office will be closed with the exception of picking up Jackpot checks. So, no payments will be taken after 12:00 pm Saturday; please don't come in and ask for exceptions because you will be told no.

The Contestant meeting on Saturday at 6:00 pm is MANDAOTRY FOR ALL CONTESTANTS. We will cover important rules and clarifications. Also, just to clarify contestants must wear their back number at all times, whether on grounds or not. Western attire is only mandatory when you are competing or on the arena floor in designated areas. You do not need a separate wrist band for entry.
