Contestants must attend a meeting Wednesday, September 13, 2023 at 6:00 PM in the Washington County Sales Facility with their parent(s) or guardian(s) to be eligible to participate in the contest. Personal interviews will take place Saturday afternoon, September 16, 2023. Interview times will be drawn at the September 13th meeting.
- 3. Contestants should wear western attire for the contest and interview. Shorts are not permissible.
- 4. A candid photograph of each contestant, no larger than 5X7, should be included with their entry form. STUDIO PHOTOGRAPHS will not be accepted.
- 5. The boy and girl selected Little Mister and Little Miss must appear on behalf of the Fair Association when asked. If for some reason the child is unable to fulfill his or her responsibilities, for example, by moving out of the county, the first runner up will assume the title.
- 6. Contestants will ride in the Washington County Fair Parade on September 16, 2023. Winners will also ride in the 2024 Maifest Parade.
- 7. The Washington County Fair Association will not be responsible for loss; injury or damage to person or property while a contestant is either on the fairgrounds or at any Fair related function.
- 8. Release of liability form must be signed and submitted with entry.
