- 2. All steers must be on the fairgrounds before the end of the official weigh in.
- 3. All breeds and crosses will show together.
- 4. Market steer classes will be set after the official weigh in. It is suggested that a minimum of three (3) animals constitute a class.
- 5. Steers must be slick sheered with no more than 1/4" of hair on any part of the body, except the tail switch, (the tail switch being no more than 12" above the end of the cartilage of the tail).
- 6. Steers must be de-horned and broke to lead in an orderly manner. Unruly steers will not be permitted to show.
- 7. Steer minimum weight is 1000 pounds
- 8. Only State validation or Hunt County validation tags will be allowed in the ear. All other

identification ear tags MUST be removed before entering the show ring.
