Source Materials for both Levels:

- City/Community Questions asked in the 2nd Period can be about many different cities in the East Texas area that participate in Academic Rodeo, but do not necessarily participate in ACQ. A document contains information about these towns and cities, as well as the counties of East Texas.
- School questions in the 2nd Period about those registered in the contest will include such questions as school colors, mascots, city or county location, and any interesting facts or famous people associated with the school.
