Calf Scramble Participation Rules

1. Application and minor release forms must be submitted to the State Fair of Louisiana Office by October 28, 2024. Contestants will be notified of their acceptance as well as the date and time, they are to participate.
2. Applicant must be enrolled in 4-H or FFA within the State of Louisiana at the time of application.
3. Applicant must be 9 years of age, no older than 18 years of age and eligible to show in the 2025 State Fair Livestock Show as set forth in the Livestock show rules and guidelines.
4. Applicant will be fiducially responsible for any additional funds needed to purchase the animal above the \$500 allocation, along with expenses for feed and care of animal.
5. Applicant must agree to exhibit the animal at the 2025 State Fair Livestock Show.
6. The State Fair of Louisiana will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any participant in the calf scramble before, during or after the event.

Physical Requirements (Due to the type of event and size of calves)

1. Applicant must weigh at least 50 pounds.
2. Participants arriving the day of event and appearing to have broken limbs or evidence of a recent injury (cast, ace bandage, support brace, etc) will not be allowed to participate.

Calf Scramble Recipient Purchase Requirements:

1. A Purchase Certificate in the amount of \$500.00 will be issued to winners participating in the calf scramble event. These certificates must be used in the purchase of an animal to be shown at the 2025 State Fair Livestock show. The animal must also be approved by your 4-H Agent or FFA Advisor and the State Fair of Louisiana Livestock Manager.
2. Recipients may NOT purchase animals from themselves, immediate family members, family ranches/partnerships, or the exhibitors 4-H Agent or FFA Advisor.
3. If the animal is purchased for less than the certificate amount, a check will be issued to the seller for the actual cost of the animal. Under no circumstances will checks be issued to the exhibitor, parent or agent.
4. The purchase price may be over the \$500 however any amount that exceeds this amount is the responsibility of the calf scramble participant.
5. Recipients must have possession of the animal by the published possession date as stated in the State Fair of Louisiana Livestock Show rules for the 2025 Show Season.
6. Upon purchase the Seller or Recipient must mail the certificate of purchase to the State Fair of Louisiana Livestock, 3701 Hudson Ave., Shreveport, La. 71109 along with an invoice that includes the Sellers Name, address and contact phone number. Note: No farm or ranch names, please utilize seller given name. Also the request for funds must be turned into the State Fair no later than 30 days from possession date.
7. Recipients are required to mail a **5 x 7 color photo** and **thank you card** to the State Fair Livestock Office upon purchase. The State Fair will in-turn send the photo and thank you cards to the appropriate sponsors.
8. Recipients who fail to fulfill all or part of the obligations as listed will result in the revocation of all rights to this purchase certificate and possible repayment of all or part of the value of the purchase certificate to the State Fair of Louisiana.

Contest Rules

1. The only individuals allowed in the arena floor with the contestants will be State Fair of Louisiana Staff and volunteers approved by State Fair of Louisiana staff. Family members of contestants are NOT allowed on the arena floor.
2. Halters will already have been placed on the calves. At the blow of the whistle to start, contestants will attempt to catch the lead rope of the halter that has been previous put on the calves and hold onto the rope while leading the calf to the winner's circle.
3. If two or more contestants catch the same calf, the calf will be turned loose.
4. If a contestant has a hold of a calf, no other contestant will be allowed to touch the calf unless it breaks away.
5. The contestant who secures and leads a calf to the winners circle will be declared the winner as indicated by the referees.
6. Poor sportsmanship will automatically disqualify the contestant. Undue roughness will not be tolerated, whether towards the participant or to the animal.
