Registration

Pre-registration is not required. All teams will be registered on the day of the contest. Team coaches should register the whole team at one time and collect the required material for all youth. Youth members should bring their own pencils and clipboards.

At the conclusion of each contest, the **contest supervisor** will ask for the winners' names, addresses, and other pertinent information so that the awards can be distributed. This completed record will be given to the Livestock Secretary.

RULES

- A Horticulture Judging Team shall consist of three (3) or four (4) bona fide 4-H Club or FFA Chapter members whose ages are 8-18. The three highest scores from a four-person team will be used in competition. It is strongly recommended that all contestants wear appropriate 4-H or FFA attire.
- There are five (5) Divisions:
 1. FFA Junior Division/Middle School Students
 2. FFA Senior Division/Senior High Students
 3. 4-H Junior Division: 4-H member between 8-10 yrs. as of Sept. 1st of current year
 4. 4-H Intermediate Division: 4-H member between 11-13 yrs. as of Sept. 1st of current year
 5. 4-H Senior Division: A 4-H member who is 14-18 yrs. as of Sept. 1st of current year

Clover buds (ages 5-7) are welcome to judge for practice and will be awarded a participation ribbon.
