- 1. This contest **must** take place at school, and is for Kindergarten, 1st & 2nd Grades only.
- 2. Each school will send only two (2) winning entries per grade level.
- 3. For private schools, send back to your school office. They will contact Cynthia Riley at (334) 797-1259 or by email <u>crriley2@icloud.com</u>. Entries should be returned by Monday, October 21, 2024. (NO entries will be accepted after the October 21st deadline). Dothan City and Houston County schools return entries to the superintendent's office by the deadline.
- 4. The schools will be notified by phone if they have winners, <u>providing all information is ON the Coloring Contest page</u>. To be contacted as a winner, it is vital that all information is provided, <u>especially school name and phone number</u>.
- 5. The winners will be contacted through the schools to pick up their prizes. Prizes and coloring sheets may be picked up from the fairgrounds on Monday, November 11, 2024, between the hours of 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM. Any preliminary winner who would like to have his/her coloring sheet back (they must be informed by the school) will need to come to the fairgrounds during these times. Entries that are not picked will be returned to the student's school during the week of November 11th. PLEASE DO NOT SEND A WINNER WITHOUT A CURRENT CONTACT NUMBER OR SCHOOL NAME.
- 6. Prizes: There will be a First, Second and Third place winner in each grade level.
