

The Stampede is a non-profit organization that relies on community volunteers. As a thank you, the Stampede donated back over \$93,800 in 2024 to support the mission of the volunteer groups for their efforts.

Every year, the Greeley Stampede improves our community by enhancing our home, Island Grove Park. From simple tasks like painting handrails to exciting projects like the new JBS Stage, we make improvements to the city owned park that benefit everyone. As the main renters, we ensure these upgrades serve anyone utilizing the park, and once completed, they become city property. We couldn't do this without the incredible support of our community and partners. Since 1992, we've invested over \$11.7 million in making Island Grove and Greeley top destinations for events.





The Greeley Stampede Foundation, a 501c3 nonprofit organization, was established in 2001 and has grown to impact more than just graduating high school students by awarding more than \$1,000,000 to various educational programs and scholarships. Funding for the Greeley Stampede Foundation comes from annual events produced by the Greeley Stampede including the Stampede Golf Tournament, Western Art Show & Gala, Big Buckle Ball, and the new Ray Esola Memorial Sporting Clay Tournament. Financial support was also received in 2024 from numerous personal memorial donations, the Old Bucker organization, The Weld Trust, First Interstate Bank, and the Evans Sam's Club Spark Good Local grant program.

In 2024, the Greeley Stampede Foundation awarded \$102,000 to support local students and educational programs including awarding twenty-seven \$2,500 scholarships for graduating high school seniors, high school rodeo athletes, college rodeo athletes, Miss Rodeo Colorado, and an Aims Community College student in the Emergency Medical Services program. The Greeley Stampede Foundation also sponsored the Weld County School District 6 Back-to-School event, awarded \$1,000 scholarships to students that are attending alternative schools, provided \$500 grants to students who are focused on trade skills, and supported two \$2,500 projects at Platte Valley High School and Meeker Elementary. With support of The Weld Trust, a new continuation scholarship program was created to award a second year of scholarship money to Stampede scholarship recipients from the previous year who applied and were selected.
