

2024 Demolition Derby Rules – Power Wheels

Power Wheels Rules and Entry

This is meant to be fun for the kids and families. Please follow the Rules of Entry and Participation below.

1. ENTRY FEE is \$10 per vehicle. Fee does not include Pit Pass or Grandstands admission fee.
2. Open to children ages 3 – 10 years.
3. Each child/entry will drive their own Power Wheel vehicle.
4. All kids must be accompanied by an Adult/Guardian during the Power Wheels event.
5. No modifications to the car other than stated here, within these rules.
6. You must provide your own Power Wheels Vehicle.
7. Power Wheels need to be the type where the child sits IN not ON.
8. No motorcycles, tractors, or 4-Wheelers. It must be a vehicle they sit IN not ON.
9. Must have a well-fitting helmet, long sleeved shirt, long pants and closed toe shoes are required.
10. Secure doors and hoods so they do not come open. Bungy cord, duct tape or zip ties recommended.
11. Seat belts are not mandatory but highly recommended.
12. No special reinforcement. It must be the way the Power Wheel was initially designed by the manufacturer. Demolition Derby designs, sponsors, decoration, paint, etc. allowed.
13. No raising or lowering of the front or the rear of the Power Wheel.
14. Stock Battery can be replaced. It can be positioned anywhere inside the car except for the passenger seat. It must be secured and covered.
15. No screws, Velcro or anything else may be attached to tires. They must be stock tires.
16. After registration and inspection, all Power Wheel Vehicles must be put in a designated area assigned.
17. Type(s) of event(s) will be determined by Modern Day Gladiators and the Judges.
18. Awards will be given out.
19. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES, SCORE KEEPERS WILL BE FINAL!!!!
20. At time of registration parent/guardian of child must sign a waiver and release of liability and indemnity agreement. Parent/Guardian **must supervise and be with the child at all times** when in the pit area and during this event. Only the child registered for the Power Wheels heat will be allowed in the arena, during the heat. Children MUST remain outside of the arena at all other times.
21. All participants must comply with these rules and regulations. It is furthermore agreed that all entries, pit crew, driver, owner, sponsors, safety personnel, EMTs, and law enforcement will comply with these rules.
22. No expressed or implied warranties of any kind.
23. This is a guide set forth for the conduct of the sport and no way a guarantee against injury or death to the spectator, participant or official. Modern Day Gladiators Promotions has the right to accept or reject any entry without notice.

Parent/Guardian must read rules and sign waiver for child to participate at the Pit Pass Entry Sign-in area, North Gate Tent, upon arrival. All parents and pit crew members must be 16 years of age or older, must be able to provide proof of age and picture identification. (Driver's License or Secretary of State ID Card)

Parent or Guardian must supervise child(ren) at all times during Power Wheels event. Parents will stay with their car in the pit area. No parking of trucks or trailers in the Pit Area, unless approved by Derby Management/Fair Board.

Only the child registered for the Power Wheels event will be allowed in the arena, during the event only, and return to the grandstands or pit area after the event has finished.

No one under 16 years of age, not registered with a Power Wheels, is permitted in the in-field arena during the duration of the show.

No alcoholic beverages in the pit area, only in the designated Beer Garden location and Grandstands.

Persons who volunteer/participate/spectate in this event do so at their sole risk. Insurance coverage of any type is not provided by Modern Day Gladiator Promotions, Boulder County Fair, Livestock Show & Rodeo, Boulder County, its Board of County Commissioners, Fair Board, its employees, its agents, or its assigns, regarding any injury, loss or liability that may arise through the participation in the event.

Further, volunteers and participants agree to release and hold harmless Boulder County, the Boulder County Fair, Livestock Show & Rodeo, and its assignees from any loss, damage, injury or liability that may arise through or as a participant in the event.

By signing the **Acknowledgement and Waiver of Liability**, I agree to abide by all rules and regulations pertaining to the event. I further agree and understand Boulder County, the Boulder County Fair, Livestock Show & Rodeo and its assignees are not responsible for my actions, and I release and absolve them from any liability associated with this event.
