- 1. Exhibitors must read and be familiar with, and comply with, the Boulder County Fair General Rules and Regulations, Open Creative Living General Rules and Regulations, and any applicable division or class rules.
- 2. Entries must have been produced by the exhibitor.
- 3. Entries must have been produced within the past year.
- 4. Entries must include a 3" by 5" index card stating the information specified in the class descriptions below.
- 5. Entries must be picked up between 4:00 and 6:00pm on Monday, August 12. The exhibitor is responsible for collecting their entry or making arrangements to have them picked up.
- 6. All ages may enter.
- 7. An exhibitor may have only two entries per class.
- 8. Items must be clean, but need not be "new." They may have been worn or used during the year, but must not look worn-out. Soiled garments will be disqualified.
- 9. Bring garments on plain hangers only (superintendent will not be responsible for special hangers).
- 10. Articles that have name labels or "created by" tags need to be removed or covered.
- 11. Entries may be assigned to another or new class at the discretion of the judge or superintendent.
