RULES:

- 1. Exhibitors must read and be familiar with, and comply with, the Boulder County Fair General Rules and Regulations, Open Creative Living General Rules and Regulations, and any applicable division or class rules.
- 2. Entries must have been produced by the exhibitor.
- 3. Entries must be original works created within the last two years (screen prints that are manually reproduced are acceptable).
- 4. Entries must not have been previously entered at the Boulder County Fair.
- 5. Entries must be appropriate for family-friendly viewing (no nudity, politics or political statements, religion or religious subjects, violence, etc.)
- Entries will be handled with care. Your submission of artwork for exhibit automatically waives any claim for damage or loss against the Longmont Artists' Guild, Boulder County Fair, its members, or its assigns.
- 7. Entries must be picked up between 4:00 and 6:00pm on Monday, August 12. The exhibitor is responsible for collecting their entry or making arrangements to have them picked up.
- 8. Al-generated work will not be accepted.
- 9. Exhibitors must be adults 18 and over (as of December 31, 2023).
- 10. An exhibitor may have only two entries total (i.e. one painting in Class 01 and one drawing in Class 02 or two paintings in Class 01).
- 11. Entries may be assigned to another or new class at the discretion of the judge or superintendent.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Entry Size:
 - a. 2D Art: Artwork is to be no larger than 18" x 24" with a frame.
 - b. 3D Art: Artwork is to be no larger than 24" x 24" x 24" and weigh no more than 20 lbs.
- 2. Mounting:
 - a. 2D Art: Artwork must be ready for display (dry, suitably framed, and sufficiently wired for hanging with no saw tooth hangers or bare glass edges). Gallery-wrapped work is acceptable.
 - b. 3D Art: Artwork should be sturdy and moveable with no loose parts and not dangerous for public display. Pedestal supplied by the exhibitor is required.
- 3. The FRONT of each entry may not have any information (artist, price, etc.) except for the title of the work.
- 4. The BACK of each entry must contain the following information:
 - a. Exhibitor's name
 - b. Exhibitor's phone number
 - c. Title or work
 - d. Tag with sale information (if item is for sale)

- Class 01: Paintings (oil, acrylic, pastel, watercolor, gouache, etc.)
- Class 02: Mixed Media (use of two or more different media in the same project)
- Class 03: Drawing (pen & ink, pencil, charcoal, colored pencil, etc.)
