HOURS, TICKETS, PARKING

- **HOURS** Gates open daily Monday-Friday from 5:00-9:30pm, and Saturday-Sunday from 11am-9:30pm on both weekends.
- **LOCATION** The Fairgrounds Nashville at 320 Wedgewood Ave.
- **TICKETS** Purchase at Nashfair.fun to save money and time! Prices range from \$7-10.
- **PARKING** Available on- and off-site. On-site parking is \$10 cash in lots along Craighead St. Fair shuttles provide free rides to and from parking lots and the main entrance.

ENTERTAINMENT

- LIVE MUSIC See 60+ acts over 3 stages with live music every day at our Courtyard Stage (main stage), 615 Stage (local acts) & Skyliner Stage (bluegrass).

THE FAIR EXPOSITIONS

- **THE AG-TIVITY HALL** (Expo 1) houses the free Milk Bar, livestock show arena, corn crib, rabbits, poultry, duck race, petting zoo, goat gym, Tiny Acres, Nora the milking cow, the Ham Cooking Show, live milking demos, and all things agricultural.
- **CREATIVE ARTS** (Expo 2) features all the art & garden entries from our competitive events, the Live Butterflies exhibit, the Living Zultar, our bluegrass music stage, the Skyliner Grill, craft stations, and bee & honey education.
- **THE MARKETPLACE** (Expo 3) is home to our STEAM stage featuring science shows and ventriloquism, punctuated by aerial entertainment, our 10 day balloon build, LEGO® tables, a Mothers' Tent, a Sensory Space, community booths, and vendor booths.

SPECIAL CULTURAL EVENTS

- **THE FESTIVAL OF THE NATIONS** This incredible festival brings performers of various talents and nationalities to dance, sing, celebtrate, and present special performances from their respective cultures in the courtyard for both weekends of the fair!
- **EL JEFE DAY** The Hispanic community comes together with fairgoers for an early celebration of Mexican Independence Day to celebrate with mechanical games, snacks, exhibitions, face painting, Aztec dance, animals, and folklore with many musical guests all day on Sunday, September 8!

PARENT PRO TIPS

- Children under 5 are free. Metro students should get a ticket at school for free entry Monday thru Thursday of the fair. The best wristband deals are online before Sept. 6.
- Water fountains and milk from the Milk Bar are available in the AGtivity Hall. Water fountains in all expo halls include water bottle refill stations. There are restrooms in all 3 halls and port-a-potties on The Midway.
- The Mothers' Tent, located in the Marketplace, is great for private changes and feeding.
- Our Sensory Space in the Marketplace is available for a calming space if needed and includes with fidget toys and sensory headphones.
- * Don't miss the corn crib in the AGtivity Hall, complete with benches for tired feet while watching your kids play.
