

Outrider Ambassador & Promotions Program (seasonal)

2024 Position Overview

Outriders will help with event promotions including community engagement, special events, and rodeo activities to support the Greeley Stampede objectives and goals. They will also serve as event ambassadors at community networking events and assist our mascot program throughout the event. We strive to give all of our interns a well-rounded experience and will move you around to as many areas as time allows.

Essential Job Functions

- Represent and promote the Greeley Stampede at community networking events including Chamber Business Before Hours, Chamber Business After Hours and Young Professional events.
- Support special event promotions including the Kickoff Concert, hosted Chamber events, trade show booths, community parades and the Big Buckle Ball.
- Support sponsor promotions including rodeo promotions, onsite engagement, rodeo contestant bags, and rodeo day sheets.
- Support event promotions including Barrel Painting, Behind the Chutes tours, Read to the Stampede, Family Funday, Parade in the Park etc.
- Support the mascot program and help coordinate appearances.
- Represent the Greeley Stampede by delivering hospitality packages as needed.
- Support the marketing campaign by assisting with the distribution of marketing materials including brochures, posters and yard signs.
- Support general office duties including document filing, paper shredding and mailing.
- Helping present to organizations an overview of what the Stampede is about.
- Roaming the park obtaining social media footage to be used at a later day/ during the event

Minimum Qualifications

- Computer skills and experience including Microsoft Office products
- Oral and written communications skills including public speaking
- Organizational and interpersonal skills
- Ability to demonstrate initiative and resourcefulness, combined with a very strong teamoriented approach to work
- Ability to read, write and speak the English language fluently; ability to present verbal and written material to the general public
- Valid driver's license

Work Schedule

- The Outrider program is a partially paid internship program and is a seasonal hourly non-exempt position that is scheduled to work from April 1st, 2024 -July 12th, 2024.
- The position will require flexible scheduling of work to accommodate peak times. You will have work days in the office but most promotions will fall on weekends and nights.
- Please note that end times of events are estimated. Please do not make plans on the same day, immediately following promotions.
 - April: 8-10 hours for the month
 - May: 8-15 hours per week
 - June: 15-30 hours per week (first three weeks)
 - Event: 40+ hours per week (projected 9-10 hour days with a few 12-13 hour days thrown in)
 - Post-event: 8-15 hours per week
- Average total internship hours: 210-250 hours

Non-Negotiable Dates

While we try to be accommodating prior to the start of event there are a few days that will be nonnegotiable when accepting this internship. You will be provided a projected schedule and start/end times for each day. This is subject to change so please do not make plans on these days as we might ask you to come in earlier or stay later.

- Kick off Concert: June 13th
- Work Day and Big Buckle Ball: June 21st
- Dates of the Event: June 25th July 6th
- Cleanup Day: July 7th
