- Stalls will be available starting Friday of fair week; must be paid with entries. Prior to Friday, stall rentals must be approved by the Show Manager.
- Horses may be led to the arena gate, but riders must enter the arena without assistance. Non-compliance will result in disqualification in that class.
- Camping, with power, in the equestrian area is limited and will be on a first come first served basis to out-of-county participants and at management's discretion.
