#### **Track Event Information**

CLOSE OF ENTRIES: Track entries close at 5:00 p.m., JULY 1, 2024. Entry fee, complete entry form, and registration papers must be received at the Rodeo office before close of entries. Receipt of personal check or payment via credit card may constitute payment of entry at the sole discretion of the Rodeo.

MORNING AND AFTERNOON PERFORMANCES: In all events in which there are eliminations, the horses qualifying for further showing will be named by the judge immediately following the elimination showing. In the Stockhorse classes, the pattern performed in the FINALS may not follow that used in the elimination but may be changed to suit the Judge and the Steward Committee.

SOUNDNESS OF HORSES: All horses used in competitive track events will be inspected for soundness and age at the discretion of, and by the California Rodeo Veterinarian or the Steward Committee of the California Rodeo. The Veterinarian or Committee may disqualify any horse upon the grounds of unsoundness or age, and the decision so made will be final.

WITHDRAWING ENTRIES: Any exhibitor who withdraws from the Rodeo, or any event thereof, without sufficient cause therefore being accepted by the Steward Committee as reasonable, shall forfeit all entry fees, trophies and all previous winnings, and may be subject to such disciplinary measures as the Steward Committee shall impose. \*

NON-EXHIBITION OF ENTRIES: Horses must be shown in classes entered, this rule being subject to the exception and penalties stated in the paragraph above. All horses not in paddock when class or race is called by paddock officials may be disqualified.

RETURN OF ENTRY FEE: No entry fee shall be refunded unless a Veterinarian's Certificate is filed with acceptance by the Steward Committee prior to the scheduled exhibition certifying that failure to show, reason for withdrawing is caused accident, contagious or infectious disease or death of the horse to have been shown or there is filed with and accepted by the Steward Committee prior to the scheduled exhibition a letter by a doctor of medicine stating that he advises the patient not to perform for reason concerned with the patient's health.\*

\*Under no exception will the office fee or cattle charge be refundable.

CONTESTANTS' NUMBERS: Number must be obtained at least one (1) hour before a class event and MUST BE WORN ON CONTESTANT'S BACK. Pick up Contestant Numbers at Track Office on Midway, day of event.

EXHIBITION BY A MINOR: The guardian must sign a release on the entry form to qualify the contestant for appearance at the California Rodeo.

OFFICIALS: Paddock Announcer, Mike Lipe, Salinas, CA; Race Official, Kelly Surbeck, Salinas, CA. All races are governed by the rules of the Steward Committee of the California Rodeo.

All NRCHA classes will be judged under the rules of the National Reined Cow Horse Association except in conflict with the rules of California Rodeo Association. **All owners and riders must have current NRCHA** membership and must be in good standing with NRCHA.

JUDGES' DECISIONS WILL BE FINAL IN ALL EVENTS.

STEWARD COMMITTEE: The Steward Committee consists of the following: Braden Hoover, Track Director; Tim Baldwin, Henry Dill and Dr. Tim Eastman, Official Veterinarian.

Braden Hoover or Joe Yezek will flag all Track Events, except Barrel Race. Tina Daries will flag Barrel Race events.

FALSIFYING ENTRIES: Any person who shall place, or assent to false information on any entry blank, or who shall enter an event limited as to age or rider, to type or state of training of a horse, knowingly that the person or horse entered does not qualify for such class, may be disqualified by the Steward Committee of the Rodeo from showing in any event at the California Rodeo for a period not exceeding three (3) years and upon disqualification shall forfeit all entry fees, trophies and money won, paid or awarded in any event at the California Rodeo.

RIGHT TO CANCEL: California Rodeo shall have the exclusive right to cancel the event at any time up to the date of the event if the event is materially impacted as a result of COVID-19 restrictions in any way, or for any reason whatsoever.

#### TRACK EVENTS

NOTE: In Track events, except WPRA Barrel Race, a fee of \$14.00 per horse must accompany entry to comply with State directions that such amount is to be collected to underwrite examination and laboratory tests to comply with State regulations.

RESERVED RIGHTS: The management reserves the right to make urine and/or saliva tests on all animals entered in class and to refuse, accept conditionally, and to cancel any entries, disqualifying exhibitors, prohibit exhibitions and cancel awards of prizes without claim for damages.

FINALS: In the Stockhorse classes the pattern performed in the finals may not follow that used in the eliminations but may be changed to suit the judges and the Steward Committee.

In case of tie for 4th in the elimination, the cow work score will break the tie.
