

## Department B-07 Junior Poultry

### Important Information:

2. Schedule can be found online or on page 1. Exhibitors of livestock must inform themselves when their stock will be judged. Stock must be in the show ring promptly after being called. Any person failing to comply with order will be ruled out from competing.
3. **Use only this year's entry guide.**
4. General information that pertains to all departments can be found online and starting on page 2. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to follow all expectations.
5. All animals you plan to show MUST be registered prior to the entry deadline. Space for the show will be allocated after registration closes.
  - Each exhibitor provides cups and feed for feeding and watering their poultry.
  - Cancellation: If the poultry show is canceled because of health concerns, fees will be refunded
  - Plastic must be put down on tables under poultry cages.
  - Shavings only (no hay or straw)
  - Exhibitors are required to help clean and put cages away following the exhibition.
  - All cockerel, pullet, and waterfowl entries must be hatched on or after January 1 in the exhibit year and are referred to as young birds.
  - Hens must be hatched prior to January 1 of the exhibit year and referred to as old birds.
6. Animals may not be unloaded until all paperwork is received by the Superintendent of the department. And fees paid to the office.
  - Poultry must provide a DATCP Poultry Certification. This form is available on our website or in the Entry Office.
  - All poultry, except waterfowl, shown in public exhibition shall originate from flocks designated "U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid Clean" under the national poultry improvement plan or from equivalent flocks, or shall have had a negative pullorum. **This certificate must be filed with the Fair entry Department before the fair starts.**
  - Typhoid test within 90 days of movement to public exhibition.
  - All turkeys must be blood tested.
  - Only sexually mature birds over four months of age with a full complement of fully developed adult feathers must be tested.
  - Testing must be arranged by the registration deadline.
  - Mature birds, without testing as required, will be disqualified.
  - All birds must be inspected before entering the show barn.
7. When there are less than three exhibits entered in a class, the exhibit(s) may be moved to a Miscellaneous class at the time of judging. Learn more about this rule by researching DATCP, ATCP 160.07(1).

9. PREMISE ID REGISTRATION: If you are entering animals in this department, you must provide us with your Premise Identification Number on your entry form. 10. Exhibitors of livestock are required to display over each stall or pen occupied by their stock, a printed placard containing the name, breed, and age, with registry of the animal exhibited. 11. By participating in the Northern Wisconsin State Fair, you are agreeing to follow the Code of Ethics set forth by the NWSFA Board. Mistreatment of any animal will not be tolerated. Any exhibitor or person found mistreating animals during the exhibition will be dismissed from the fairgrounds with loss of premiums.

12. By participating you authorize the use of your image in pictures, audio, and video productions for advertising and marketing needs of the NWSF.
13. YQCA certificate number should be entered with registration. And a copy of the certificate must be presented to the fair office by July 1. Exhibitors not providing a copy of their certificate will not be allowed to show and compete in the junior fair.
14. Showmanship: must be included at the time of entry. Showmanship classes may be further divided, depending on entry number, and are the decision of the superintendent.
15. All Entries will be judged by certified specialty judges using the Danish system.
