Thank you for being a part of the oldest Fair west of the Mississippi. It is because of your dedication, hard work and knowledge that provides great representation of agriculture and farming to our Fair. We could not produce this Fair without your help! As Expo staff prepares the grounds, barns and buildings for your exhibits, we would like to take a minute and provide a few reminders and updates:

NEW BARN MANAGERS: With great excitement, we would like to introduce ourselves! We are your Barn Managers, Maddie Blechschmidt and Bella Stouffer. We have both been around this Fair for many years, and we are both College students at the University of Idaho, studying different fields of Agriculture. Bella will be managing the Rabbit Barn, Horse Barn, and Cat Area. And Maddie will be managing the Livestock Barn, Dog Barn, and Sheep Area. If you see us please say hello, we can't wait for another great Fair!

LOG SHOW PARADE: The King County Fair will have an entry at the Log Show Parade in Buckley on June 29th for the *FIRST TIME EVER!* We are pleased to welcome any and all 4-H, FFA, or Open Class Exhibitors to join us on our float. Parade staging will be on Main Street, and the parade starts at 10:00 AM!

4th OF JULY PARADE: The King County Fair will also have an entry at the parade on July 4th. We welcome any 4-H, FFA, or Open Class Exhibitor to be a part of our float,

after all, the more the merrier!!! Parade staging is along Railroad Street and the parade starts at NOON!

DAILY BREAKFAST OPTIONS: New this year, we will be having breakfast pre-orders available for our exhibitors all thanks to the Yella Beak! They are \$6.00 each, and delivered daily at 9:00 AM on Fair days! Options include brisket tacos with egg & cheese, or English muffins with egg & cheese and your choice of meat. “GENERAL STORE”: Located between the horse barn and the Rabbit Barn Bathrooms is a **General Store**. If you forgot something, check the store, we may have it. From Advil and mints to sanitizing wipes and sunscreen we got you covered! Also available for a 3rd year are various King County Fair and Bessie shirts, hats, water bottles, and stickers that are available for purchase.

NORTH TICKET BOOTH ENTRANCE & GATES: The grounds will open at 7:00 AM every morning through the North Ticket Booth and Gate 1 & 6.

FAIR BOARD: In the event there is a mishap or disagreement in a barn, there is a Fair Board that consists of 5 community members that will hear the formal complaint to make a decision for settling a dispute. The complaint must be in writing and submitted to the *Fair Manager*. The Fair Manager will submit the complaint to the Board with a decision to be made within 24 hours if needed. Please seek your Barn Manager FIRST for questions and/or concerns.

TARGET AUDIENCE DAYS: We will be having “Target Days” fair-wide each day this year, be sure to inform your friends and family if a day relates to them!

- Thursday, **July 11th is SENIOR DAY:** Fair Admission is \$1.00 for those who are 60+ ALL DAY!
- Friday, **July 12th is FIRST RESPONDERS DAY:** FREE ADMISSION with badge for Police, Fire & Healthcare.
- Saturday, **July 13th is WILD WILD WEST:** FREE PARKING from 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm with your Rodeo ticket.
- Sunday, **July 14th is MILITARY DAY:** All active and retired military personnel receive FREE ADMISSION with Military ID.

SUNDAY: Market Steers and Hogs will be picked up by haulers at 5:00 PM. NO OTHER ANIMALS CAN BEGIN THE LOAD-OUT PROCESS UNTIL 6:00 PM or THE HAULER IS DONE LOADING (WHICHEVER IS LATER).

All participants MUST tear down and help clean up the barns. Animal pens, cages, and collapsible tables must be broken down and stacked in a designated location by the barn superintendent. Please do your part and help breakdown so the barn can simply be cleaned out Monday AM by just moving pallets of stacked cages and pens.

ENTRY/WRISTBAND: All participants will need to purchase entry wristbands and

parking (if needed).

FAIR OFFICE: The fair office will be open on Saturday, July 6th and Sunday, July 7th from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. Pre-ordered packets can be picked up at this time or during regular office hours.

MANDATORY BARN MEETINGS: As a reminder, there will be a mandatory 9:00 AM barn meeting each day. All participants must be in attendance at the meeting each day. Important daily announcements will be presented at this time.
