



2024 POSTER CONTEST RULES

- Poster contest will be open to children in the <u>third, fourth and fifth grades</u>. Please bring your entry to your school by October 18th, 2024. A first and second place poster will be chosen from each school grade level. The winning posters from the school will be taken to the Board of Education in your district by October 22nd. Homeschool entries should be taken to the NPF Office.
- 2. Posters must be 14 inches by 22 inches, which is one-half vertical sheet of poster board. <u>FULL SIZE POSTERS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.</u> We do not have sufficient space for displaying full size posters.
- 3. Any type of medium (chalk, paint, crayons, pencils, charcoal, felt markers or any combination) must be used. Other decorative items may be added as long as it is something flat. Nothing can hang off the poster.
- 4. The theme of the poster must be: "A Family Tradition for 80 Years".
- 5. Posters may be picked up at the fairgrounds on Monday, November 11th between the hours of 4:00 PM and 6:00 PM. Posters not picked up by 6:00 PM on Monday, November 11th will be taken to the Peanut Festival office. Posters will be destroyed after two weeks. We cannot be responsible for lost posters.
- 6. On the back of each poster, in the lower right hand corner, must be the following information:

NAME, GRADE, NAME OF SCHOOL, CONTACT PHONE NUMBER AND EMAIL ADDRESS.

Posters without this information on it will be disqualified.

7. There will be three winners selected from each grade level:

1st Place	\$20.00
2 nd Place	\$15.00
3 rd Place	\$10.00
