This competition is FREE to enter! There will be 1st - 3rd place awards for best taste and a 1st place winner for best presentation! Winners will be announced at the awards ceremony at 4:30 pm inside the Harry Hafernick Recreation Center Auditorium.

Who Can Enter?

- Grab mom, dad, sister, brother, and make this a fun activity the entire family can enjoy!
- This competition is open to the public and **FREE** to enter!

Rules:

- Desserts can be Baked or Non-Baked!
- Please do not submit anything that requires refrigeration or heating.
- Recipes may come from cookbooks, magazines, websites, or any other means.
- All entries are to be submitted as a whole (complete pie, complete cake, complete loaf, etc.) or in the quantity of a half dozen or more. There will need to be enough for approximately 12 judges to taste.

What Can I Win?

- In the Taste Category, 1st 3rd Place Winners will receive an Award Banner that can be hung at your campsite or home!
- The 1st place Presentation Winner will receive an Award Banner as well!
- Winners will be announced during the awards ceremony at 4:30 p.m. inside the Harry Hafernick Recreation Center.

Dessert Judging Process:

- Judging will be performed by volunteers. The judging process will start at 2:00 p.m. in the Harry Hafernick Recreation Center at Brackenridge Park & Campground.
- Judging will be anonymous all entries will be assigned a number and judging will take place before the entrants' names are identified.
- The total number of judges will be based on the amount of entries. Early Registration by contestants will help ensure the total number of judges are secured.
