Important Dates:

- Monday, October 28th Early Entries Close
- Friday, November 1st Gate opens for arrivals at 8:00 am
- Friday, November 1st Late Entries Close at 4:00 pm
- Friday, November 1st Enter Fitting Contest at the Livestock Office by 4:00 pm
- Friday, November 1st All Registered Heifers Checked in & Commercial Heifers Weighed in by 6:00 pm
- Saturday, November 2nd All Steers & Market Heifers Weighed in by 6:00 pm

General Show Information & Rules:

- 1. All Exhibitors must be at least 4 years old and no older than 21 years old as of January 1, 2024 to be eligible to enter and show.
- 2. There will be no fitting chutes/stalling allowed to be set up between the Avenue of Champion pens and the show ring.
- 3. All animals must be washed in designated areas only.
- 4. All out of state exhibitors must comply with health and brand inspection state laws.
- 5. Show management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes for the benefit of the show.
- 6. All premiums will be mailed by the Friday after the Jackpot show to the address on the entry form.
- 7. Proper ethical care of livestock and show property is expected at all times and is punishable by show management.
- 8. All exhibitors must enter through south/livestock gate (off Fairlane, across from CalFire Station).
- 9. There will be no food, alcohol, or open beverage containers without lids allowed in the livestock barns.
- 10. There will be no smoking allowed in the livestock barns or around the show ring.
- 11. All vehicle lanes must be accessible at all times during the event. Do not block any roads or alley ways between the barns. This is for safety and maintenance issues.
- 12. No vehicles or trailers will be allowed to park inside the grounds without show management approval or a trailer spot paid for.

Entry Information:

- 1. Early entries are due Monday, October 2th.
- 2. Late entries will be accepted until Friday, November 1st by 4:00 pm with an addition \$25 per entry added late fee. There will be **NO** late fees on any futurity entries.
- 3. Entries Fees:
 - o Steers and Market Heifers \$50 per entry
 - o Breeding Heifers \$50 per entry
 - o Bred & Owned Heifers \$30 per entry
 - o Futurity Classes \$30 per entry
 - o Showmanship \$15 per entry
 - o Fitting Contest \$25 per person (Payable at show on Friday, November 1st)
- 4. Entries are available online on the Showman app.
- 5. No refunds will be available.

Arrival Deadlines:

- 1. Cattle may start arriving on Friday, November 1st at 8 am.
- 2. All registered heifers must be checked in by 6 pm on Friday, November 1st.
- 3. All commercial heifers must be weighed in by 6 pm on Friday, November 1st.
- 4. All steers and market heifers must be weighed in by 6 pm on Saturday, November 2nd.

Stalling in the Barns:

- 1. Bedding will not be provided, and **no straw or pellets will be allowed.** There will be shavings available on site available for sale on site.
- 2. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up their area. If stalls are not cleaned there will be a \$20 fee per stall.
- 3. Stalls will be assigned by show management.
- 4. Power is limited in the barns. Highly recommended to bring generators as an alternate source of power. Generators must be placed outside of the barns when in use.

Showing Out of Trailer Information:

- 1. There will be a limited number of "Show out of the Trailer Space" available for purchase at time of entering. Late entries will not be able to purchase Livestock Trailer Space.
- 2. All livestock trailers that want to park in the grass areas of the fairgrounds must purchase a "Show out of the Trailer Space." Trailers will not be permitted to park in the grass areas without pre-paying for the space.
- 3. Cost for a **Dry Spot** (**no hook ups**) is \$25 per spot per night and \$40 per spot per night with electrical hook ups. Available online until Friday, October 25th at the time of entering the jackpot show.
- 4. We kindly ask that you clean up your show out of trailer area including bedding, trash, feed and manure prior to your departure. If stalls are not cleaned there will be a \$20 fee per spot.
- 5. Livestock Trailer spaces will be pre-assigned.

RV Camping Information:

- 1. RV Camping spaces are available on the fairgrounds. One trailer per space.
- 2. The cost is \$40 per night for electrical hook ups there will be no water.
- 3. All RV campers must pre-register and pay online at the time of entering the jackpot show.
- 4. RV Camp Spaces will be pre-assigned.

Weigh-in Information:

- 1. All Steers, Market Heifers, & Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in for weight classification.
- 2. Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in by Friday, November 1st by 6 pm.
- 3. Steers & Market Heifers must be weighed in by Saturday, November 2nd by 6 pm.

Heifer Show Information:

- 1. Registered heifers will be shown by breed and age and commercial heifers will be shown by weight.
- 2. Heifers must be born between October 1, 2022 and June 1, 2024 to be eligible to show.
- 3. All registered heifers must be registered in the exhibitor's name. Registration papers must be presented at the time of check-in.
- 4. All Registered Heifers must be checked in by **Friday**, **November 1**st at 6 pm.
- 5. Registered Heifers must be shown in the breed division that they are registered. If that breed division is not available, they will show in the All Other Breeds.
- 6. If there are less than 5 heifers entered in a division the show reserves the right to scratch the division and move those heifers into the All Other Breeds Division.
- 7. Commercial Heifers must be weighed-in Friday, November 1st at 6 pm and will be shown by weight.
- 8. The Champion & Res. Champion Commercial Heifer *are eligible* to compete for Supreme Champion Heifer and Top 5 Overall Heifers.

 - All Other Breeds (AOB)
 - Angus
 - Hereford
 - Chi
 - Maine Anjou/Maintainer
 - Simmental/Simmental %

HEIFER SHOW AWARDS & PAYOUTS

- 1. The Top 3 Heifers from each breed division will be awarded the following:
 - Breed Division Champion: Cash Prize and banner
 - Res. Breed Division Champion: Cash Prize and banner
 - 3rd Overall Breed Division Champion: Cash Prize
- 2. The Overall Top 5 Heifers will be awarded a cash prize, buckle, banner, and special award
 - Supreme Champion Heifer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - Res. Supreme Champion Heifer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - 3rd Overall Heifer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - 4th Overall Heifer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - 5th Overall Heifer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner

BRED & OWNED HEIFER SHOW

- 1. Will be offered in all breeds, except Commercial Heifers.
- 2. Exhibitors in the Bred and Owned division must be the breeder and first owner, and the continuous owner of the animal entered. Breeder is defined as the recorded owner of the dam at the time of service. First owner is defined as the recorded owner of the dam at the time the calf is born.
- 3. You must enter the Bred & Owned Class if you wish to compete in the class. In order to compete in the Bred & Owned heifer class you must have entered and shown the heifer in the regular heifer show.
- 4. The Top 2 from each Bred & Owned breed division will compete for the Top 2 Overall.
 - Supreme Champion Bred & Owned Heifer: Cash Prize, Banner, & Buckle
 - Res. Supreme Champion Bred & Owned Heifer: Cash Prize, Banner, & Special Award

JACKSON COUNTY HARVEST FAIR FUTURITY HEIFER SHOW

- 1. You must enter the Futurity Show if you wish to compete in the class. In order to compete in the Futurity Show you must have entered and shown the heifer in the regular heifer show.
- 2. Class entries must provide a Bill of Sale upon check in.
- 3. The Futurity Heifer Show will follow the conclusion of the Bred & Owned Heifer Show.
- 4. Heifers will not be broken by breed, ONLY by age. There will be only one division.
- 5. The Top 2 from each class will compete for the Top 2 Overall.
 - Supreme Champion Futurity Heifer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - Res. Supreme Champion Futurity Heifer: Cash Prize & Banner

Market Show Information:

- 1. All Steers & Market Heifers must be weighed in by 6 pm on Saturday, November 2nd.
- 2. All Steers & Market Heifers must be weighed in for weight classification. Steer Weigh in's will take place on Friday and Saturday. Check the schedule for times.
- 3. The Top 3 from each weight & color division for steers and top 3 market heifers will be awarded the following:
 - Division Champion: Cash Prize and Banner
 - Res. Division Champion: Cash Prize and Banner
 - 3rd Overall Division Champion: Cash Prize
- 4. The Overall Top 5 Market will be awarded a cash prize, buckle, banner, and special award.
 - Supreme Champion Steer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - Res. Supreme Champion Steer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - 3rd Overall Steer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - 4th Overall Steer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
 - 5th Overall Steer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner

MARKET HEIFER SHOW:

- 1. Market Heifers will not be broken by color, ONLY by weight. There will be only one division.
- 2. A Top 3 Market Heifers will be selected to compete for the Top 5 Overall Market Animal.

STEER SHOW:

- 1. Divisions & Classes will be divided by weight after weigh-in. There will be two weight divisions, Prospect & Progress.
- 2. Each weight division will have three color divisions:
 - British**
 - All Other Color (AOC)
 - Black X
- 3. ** British steer will be classified at the discretion of show management.
- 4. A Top 5 will be selected from each weight division to compete for the Top 5 Overall Steers.

JACKSON COUNTY HARVEST FAIR FUTURITY MARKET SHOW:

- 1. You must enter the Futurity Show if you wish to compete in the class. In order to compete in the Futurity Show you must have entered and shown the steer/heifer in the regular steer/market heifer show.
- 2. Class entries must provide a Bill of Sale upon check in.
- 3. Market Heifers and Steer will show together and will not be broken by color, ONLY by weight. There will be only one division.
- 4. The Futurity Market Show will follow the conclusion of the regular Steer Show.
- 5. The Top 2 from each class will compete for the Top 2 Overall.

- Supreme Champion Futurity Market Steer: Cash Prize, Buckle, & Banner
- Res. Supreme Champion Futurity Market Steer: Cash Prize & Banner

Showmanship Information:

- 1. There will be two days of showmanship competition (Showmanship A & B). You must enter each day if you wish to compete in both showmanship competitions.
- 2. Cattle Showmanship ages will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2024.
- 3. Age Divisions will include:
 - Pee Wee Showmanship: Ages 4-8
 - Junior Showmanship: Ages 9-12
 - Intermediate Showmanship: Ages 13-16
 - Senior Showmanship: Ages 17-21
- 4. A Top 2 will be selected from each age division.

Mechanics Bank Fitting Contest Information:

- 1. The Fitting Contest will be held Friday, November 1st at 5 pm.
- 2. Each team must consist of 2 members.
- 3. Exhibitors will need to come to the Livestock Office by 4 pm on Friday, November 1st to enter and pay to compete in the fitting contest.
- 4. Each team is responsible bringing their own animal, setting up their chute, and having all supplies in the showring by 5 pm.
- 5. The teams will have **one hour** to fit their animal to what they consider to be showring ready.
- 6. At the conclusions of the hour each team will present their animal for judging.
- 7. A Champion and Res. Champion will be selected.
