

2024 Saunders County Fair Pickup Pull

4WD Stock Gas Class Rules

**If you are unsure/want some clarification on any of these rules, contact the class techs prior to the pull. We hate to turn anyone away, so please follow the rules and ask questions well beforehand so you have time to comply if need be.*

- Weight Classes of 6200lbs and 7000lbs
- Front Weight Brackets Allowed with 400lb Deduction-Weight Classes of 5800lbs and 6600lbs. End of Weights/Bracket may be a Max Length of 60" from the Center of the Front Axle to the Furthest Point of Weights or Bracket.
- No Weights in the Cab, Under the Hood or in the Backseat. Weights go in the Pickup Box or on the Optional Front Weight Bracket Securely.
- Hitch: Must use a Reese Style Receiver Hitch in Factory Location with a Twist Clevis or Receiver Hitch with a Minimum Opening of 3"W and 3.75"L. Must be able to Hook from Top.
- 26" Max Hitch Height
- Any Hitch or Weight Bracket Deemed Unsafe will not be Allowed to Pull.
- No Blocked Suspension or Ladder/Traction Bars, Suspension must have a minimum of 1" of Travel.
- A 5/16" Chain or 3/8" Steel Rod Must be Welded or Bolted (With 2 3/8" Bolts) to the Frame/Crossmember and Loop Around the Rear Driveshaft to Keep it from coming in Contact with the Fuel Tank or Ground in the Event of Breakage.
- Must be Currently Licensed and Street Legal. Must have Mufflers/Exhaust that Extends Behind the Cab.
- DOT Approved Tires
- Pump Gas Only, No Racing Fuel, Alcohol or NOS.
- No Passengers
- Any Weights, Parts, Items, Etc. that Fall off the Truck During the Pull will Result in a DQ.
