PREMIER EXHIBITOR PROGRAM FRUIT CROP PROJECTS

The Osceola County Fair offers its Premier Exhibitor Program to 4-H and FFA exhibitors in the Market Animal Programs, Heifer Program, and/ or Fruit Crop Program. The objective of the Premier Exhibitor Program is to highlight those exhibitors who best exemplify all aspects of the Market Animal Program, Auction Birds or Fruit Crop Program.

The Premier Exhibitor is a points system based on exhibitor participation beyond the required minimum. Points will be based on scoring and are given for the following: (Primary Project Only)

Record Book Scores and Placings

<u>Citrus Tree Show Placings</u> <u>Youth Exhibits</u>

<u>Personally, Delivered Buyer Letters</u> <u>Blueberry Plant Placings</u> <u>Citrus, or Blueberry Tabletop</u> <u>Resume (Seniors Only)</u>

<u>Demonstrations</u> <u>Essay/Video</u>

Resume Optional for Junior and Intermediate

Attending / Leading workshops

Premier Exhibitor Workshop

At the end of the year, based on the number of points you have earned, you could win the Premier Exhibitor Award for the Fruit Crop Project. An applicant must have a minimum of 150 points to be considered for a Fruit Crop Premier Exhibitor placing.

1st Place Belt Buckle, \$75. And Jacket

2nd Place – Ribbon and \$50.

3rd Place – Ribbon and \$25.

KVLS does not require your participation in the Premier Exhibitor Program. Verification forms must be completed correctly to receive your points.

You must accumulate a minimum of 150 points to be considered for the Fruit Crop Premier Exhibitor award. In the event of a Tie, the following will be used to determine the Tie Breaker:

1) Score on Record Book

2) Essay/Video

3) Tabletop Placing

If you are exhibiting in more than one fruit crop project area, you can only compete in Premier Exhibitor Project with your primary project.

PLEASE TURN YOUR VERIFICATION FORMS IN USING A NOTEBOOK OR LARGE MANILLA ENVELOPE BE CERTAIN YOUR NAME IS ON ALL YOUR PAPERWORK!!!

You are required to register for the Premier Exhibitor Award online by <u>December 13, 2025</u>. When you register, you are registering to compete in the Fruit Crop Premier Exhibitor Program. This means that you are competing against all exhibitors in that category. An exhibitor may register to compete in a maximum of three (3) Premier Exhibitor Programs. (Primary Market Animal and/ or Fruit Crop).

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Premier Exhibitor packet and <u>CITRUS record book</u> must be turned in at the Skill-A-thon day-January 29, 2025.


