ELIGIBILITY:

- Exhibitors must be a current member of Osceola County 4-H.
- Exhibitors must be between the ages of 5-7, exhibitors must be five (5) years old by September 1st of the current year.

CHECK-IN SATURDAY:

- All entries will be turned in on check-in day (See the online fair calendar for exact date and time) except for Baked Goods, Small Animals and Horticulture. Check-in will be from 12-4 pm.
- All Rabbit and Poultry animals must be transported in an animal safe carrier or cage to and from the fair.

CHECK-IN THURSDAY:

- All Baked Goods, Horticulture and Small Animals will be checked in from 5-7 pm. (See the online fair calendar for exact date and time)
- All Rabbit and Poultry animals must be transported in an animal safe carrier or cage to and from the fair. Check-in will be from 3-7 pm
- ALL CARRIERS are to be taken home after Rabbit and/or Poultry check-in. Due to the size of carriers and storage space, carriers are not to be used as your supply/show box. (new)

ENTRIES:

- <u>BAKED GOOD AND CRAFT EXHIBITS:</u> Cloverbuds may enter a **total of seven (7) entries**. This is separate from live animal and fruit crop show entries.
- <u>LIVE ANIMAL/ FRUIT CROPS AND SHOW EXHIBITS</u>: Rabbit, poultry, small animal, fruit crops, Share the Fun, Talent Show, egg show, showmanship, skill-a-thon or costume contest are separate from non-animal exhibits.
- Any late entries will be for display only (no premiums will be awarded)

JUDGING:

• Exhibitors must be present during the judging of Rabbits, Poultry, and Small Animals or prior arrangements made with the committee, otherwise no premiums will be paid.

PREMIUMS:

- There is no competition amongst Cloverbuds. All entries exhibited will receive a Cloverbud ribbon and a \$3.00 premium per entry **unless otherwise noted.** All premium checks will be mailed to the exhibitors after the fair.
- Please allow up to 6 weeks for the premium check to be mailed.
- Any exhibits REMOVED before checkout time will forfeit their premium money unless prior arrangements have been made with the Youth Exhibit Chair or Co-Chair.
- Any exhibits **NOT PICKED UP** during checkout time will forfeit their **PROJECT** unless previous arrangements have been made.
- Anyone can pick up your exhibits if they have your claim checks. They will be asked to sign for them.
- No Exhibits will be held in the Fair or Extension Services after check out day.
- Any remaining items will be discarded unless prior arrangements have been made.

SEPTEMBER and PRE-FAIR WORKSHOPS:

- Cloverbud Poultry and Rabbits need to be brought to Rabbit & Poultry Workshop prior to the Fair.

- Rabbit Pre-Fair Workshop & Health Inspection and Information Workshop on January 25,

- Poultry must attend the Bathing/Pest Control Workshop portion immediately following the pre-fair workshop on January 25, 2025, for those who did not attend in 2023-2024 (a list is on file with the Poultry Chair). Please bring one bird per family.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

- All animals are required to be free of disease, parasites, and mites.
- If not free of the listed above, they will be disqualified.
- All animals will be checked at check-in.

ANIMAL ELIGIBILITY:

- All small animals must be left in their own cages at the fair.
- Rabbits must be (5) months of age or older by fair check in date and youth must have rabbit by registration deadline. Poultry must be (6) months or older by fair check in date.
- For the Health and Safety, Pregnant Does will not be permitted to be shown at the fair.
- Breeding your rabbits at any time during the fair is STRICTLY PROHIBITED. Anyone who is
 found breeding their rabbits will have their Rabbits sent home and premiums will be
 forfeited. NO EXCEPTIONS. (new)

ANIMAL CARE:

- Exhibitors are required to feed and water their own animals, including rabbits, poultry, and small animals. They are also required to bring their own feed and keep their pens and cages clean.
- If not clean, premiums will be forfeited.
- Please clean out cages daily and rake under pens <u>DAILY</u>.
- For Rabbits and Poultry: <u>NO LOOSE HAY OF ANY KIND or Bedding Material allowed or permitted</u> inside the cages.
- Feeding hours must coincide with fair hours.
- Animals removed before checkout time and date will result in forfeiture of premium money.
- All animal areas must always be clean (inside/underneath/around), including checkout time.
- ANIMALS NOT PICKED UP AT CHECKOUT TIME WILL FORFEIT PREMIUMS.
- No locks are allowed on Rabbit cages, but zip-ties may be used for safety.
- LOCKS ARE REQUIRED on all Small Animal cages, with a secure cover on all aquariums or ratchet locks.

DRESS CODE:

- FOR THE RABBIT/ POULTRY/ SHOWMANSHIP SHOW:
 - All exhibitors must wear a white, sleeved, collared dress shirt or blouse, tucked in with dark blue or black western trousers or western jeans.
 - o Boots or leather closed toed shoes.

• ANIMAL TENT RULES:

- Only approved signs provided by the fair office and committees are permitted on cages and/or pens.
- Vehicles are not permitted on the fairgrounds during operating hours.
- Exhibitors are not permitted to give anything, or act as if they may give anything, to any judge during any show.
- No foam core/poster board or cardstock permitted for the health of the animals. Please do not remove the plexiglass dividers from between the cages.

COMMUNITY SERVICE: (New)

- Both adults & youth are to sign in and out of tent each time you go into feed, water, clean, barn duty, or anytime you spend time in the tent.
 Sign in sheet must be signed by the youth and parent on separate lines. Please DO NOT sign in a child or children that is/or are not present at the time. Youth will need to sign in for themselves or no credit will be given.
- Show times do not count towards community service hours.
- Other activities during the fair outside of the tent, DO NOT count towards community service hours. These activities include other shows, food booth duty or walking around the fair.

- A costume may be creatively designed to allow the animal to be perched or free standing as part of the design of the costume. If an exhibitor feels that it is necessary for an additional person to be present for the overall safety of the animal, this is permitted. (New)
- Entries will be judged on creativity and style.
- A 50 word or less narrative is to be turned into the Committee Member prior to the start of the event.

- Awards will be non-premium donations.
- Premiums will not be awarded or paid in costume categories. (new)
- Exhibitors are NOT PERMITTED to give ANYTHING to any judges or act as if they may give anything to any judges during any show.

SECTION 8 | CLOVERBUD BAKED GOODS

RULES:

 (1) ENTRY PER CLASS.
- A recipe form can be found on the fair website UNDER YOUTH EXHIBITS or at the end of this handbook and must be used for your entry.
- Recipe must be attached to the food item for judges. Please list ingredients and cooking information.
- Items must be in a **DISPOSABLE CONTAINER**. (photos of entries will be displayed in lieu of displaying actual product)
- All baked goods must be brought to the Thursday Youth Exhibit check-in from 5-7 pm.
- Items must be cooked (except candy), must contain flour (except candy), and cannot use raw eggs in recipe or have meringue (all eggs must be cooked or baked into recipe) and require NO REFRIGERATION.
- No "Friendship" bread or other products that are "aged" without refrigeration before baking. A
 minimum of five ingredients is required.

The Data Sheet must include a description of the act. Complete a data sheet for each member of a group act listing all members and each member of the act must indicate the category and class on their Youth Exhibit Registration form.

- These trees must be turned in on the same day as all other Citrus Trees and Blueberry plants; and will be exhibited in the Citrus Tree area in the tent.
- Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their tree/plant during the fair.
- Cloverbuds are permitted to participate in the skill-a-thon.

STRAWBERRY RULES:

- Each Osceola County 4H, FFA, or FCCLA member may enter one (1) entry.
- All trees/plants must be planted and grown in the container issued to them.
- Only 1 (one) plant can be planted in each pot. If more than one plant is in the pot the project will be disqualified.
- These plants must be turned in on the same day as all other fruit crop trees during Thursday Check-in. Check the online fair calendar for exact dates and time..
- Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their plant during the fair.
- Replacement plants may only be obtained within 30 days following the original issuing of plants, and only if plants from the original lot are still available.
