



WINERY INSTRUCTIONS

Arrival time and unloading instruction

Please plan to arrive between 9am and 10am on January 25, 2025. A Camofest volunteer will be available to show you where to set up on Avenue G between Sixth and Seventh streets. Once you have unloaded your vehicles or trailer you may park your car or van in the parking lot at the corner of Ave H and Sixth Street. If you are driving a truck and trailer parking is available behind Wells Fargo Bank.

What we will provide

The Camofest Planning Committee will provide tasting cups, dump buckets, trashcans and continuous trash pickup, and a box for tasting tickets.

The tasting cups are 2-ounce size, which we will provide. It is up to the discretion of each winery as to how much each tasting size is. It is up to the discretion of each winery what wines are available for tasting. We project approximately 3,000 to 4,000 festival goers.

We will have your \$100 travel voucher check for you on arrival. The tasting tickets box will be picked up at the end of the festival for each winery. The reimbursement checks for above the 250 tasting thresholds will be sent via mail no later than 2 weeks after the festival.

We will prescreen festival goers for their 21 and above ID. They will be given a 21 and over wristband. If the festival goer does not have one of these please assume they are not over 21 and should not be served. We have many helpers working the lines to check IDs. We also will have signs at the wine tent stating that you must be 21 years or older to be served and a sign we reserve the right to refuse service to anyone. We will have security there in case there is a need.

What you need to bring

You will need to bring your tent, hand sanitizer, tablecloth, signage, chairs and any décor for your tent. You will need to provide plastic cups for by the glass purchase. The size of the glass, the amount of the serving and the price of that serving is up to the discretion of each winery. You will need to provide packaging for any bottle purchases. Each winery will determine the pricing for by the bottle purchases.



Break down of festival

The festival will run from noon-6p.m. We ask that all wineries stay until at least 7p.m. with the option of staying until the festival closes. All wineries are responsible for cleaning up their space. Trashcans will be provided.
