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2025 Tehama District Fair Junior Livestock Independent Exhibitor Program

Welcome to the Tehama District Fair Independent Livestock Program. Enclosed please find your requirement forms and record book for the current year. Please make sure that you read the state and local rules for the fair. These requirements pertain to any independent exhibitor planning to sell a market animal at the Tehama District Fair.

Qualifications from State Rules:

Independent Exhibitors must be at least 9 years old by January 1, 2025 to compete in large animal (Beef, Sheep, Swine, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Boer Goats, Market & Fiber Goats, Horse, Alpaca & Llama) competitions at California Fairs.

- a. Exhibitors are eligible to compete/exhibit through December 31st of the year in which they turn 19 years of age.
- b. Youth may be ineligible to participate as Independent if documented disciplinary action involving their project(s) has been taken against them by 4-H, FFA or Grange organizations. Length of ineligibility to be determined by Fair Management.

Juniors who have been 4-H, FFA or Grange project members within 60 days (120 days for horse and market beef) prior to the fair are not eligible to compete in that project as Independent exhibitors or enter project(s) under a different organization. (Please refer to 4-H/FFA/Grange/Fairs & Expositions Youth Agreement at www.cdfa.ca.gov/fairsandexpositions

Independent exhibitors must enter an open junior or Independent class unless one is not available. If an open or Independent class is not available, junior exhibitors may enter an appropriate 4-H, FFA or Grange class. Division and/or class placement of Independents may be determined by Fair Management.

Independent junior exhibitors entering market animals must provide Fair Management with a picture of their animal, appropriate proof of ownership, permanent tag, tattoo and/or hog ear notch information 120 days prior to the fair for beef and 60 days for sheep, swine, and goats.

All junior exhibitors must have project management records and proof of supervision available as to the length of project.

All junior exhibitors must have "on ground" supervision by a responsible adult.

Note: The Tehama District Fair is governed by state rules and may impose additional local rules which supersede state rules.

Junior Livestock Independent Exhibitor Local Rules

Turn into the Fair Office Picture of you tagged market animal, hair sample from your market animal, and the Affidavit Exhibitor Parent Fair Agreement at the 120/60 Day Ownership Date:

- 120 Days for Market Steers by December 31, 2024, 5:00 pm Tehama District Fairgrounds (Call 530-527-5920 for Office Hours)
- 60 Days for Market Lambs, Hogs, & Goats by March 1, 2025, 5:00 pm –Tehama District Fairgrounds
- o 30 Days for Chickens & Rabbits March 31, 2025 Tehama District Fairgrounds

Must attend a Public Meeting between January 1st- April 30th, 2025, and complete the appropriate forms (i.e., Fair Board Meeting, City Council Meeting, Service Organizations, etc.)

Must complete at least 6 hours of Community Service (not affiliated with 4-H or FFA) and complete the appropriate forms. Community Service must be approved by Fair management.

2.0 grade point average must be maintained by an Independent. A certified copy of transcripts and GPA due with entry forms April 4, 2025. Copy must be in a sealed envelope with the school seal. Record Books due no later than June 9th, 2025, by 5:00 pm

Entry Forms must be turned in by April 4th, 2025, by 5:00 pm with YQCA Certificates, certified transcripts, a Bill of Sale, and a Proposition 12 certificate (prop 12 certificate for market hogs only).

During Fair week all exhibitors and their adult supervisor must sign in daily at the livestock office by 8:00 am.

Please be sure to read the Rules in the Exhibitor Handbook that will apply during the week of Fair for both showing and selling your animal.

Exhibitor / Parent Fair Agreement

Livestock Department Independent Exhibitors must be at least 9 years of age and must not be older than 18 years of age on January 1, 2025. Exhibitors' $4^{th} - 8^{th}$ grades will show with 4-H and $9^{th} - 12^{th}$ will show with FFA.

Ownership Requirements: Independent Exhibitors must meet all ownership requirements. Independent Exhibitors must enter an open Junior or Independent class unless one is not available. If an open or independent class is not available, junior exhibitors may enter in an appropriate 4-H, FFA, or Grange Class.

Parent/Guardian Signature: On the entry form a parent/guardian signature is required by the fair to certify that: projects have been under their direct supervision in accordance with the rules and regulations of the fair; and the entry us the project of the exhibitor and is eligible for exhibit. Failure or refusal of parent/guardian to sign the required entry form will prevent the exhibitor from entering that particular class(es).

Leaving an Organization: Juniors who have been a 4-H, FFA, or Grange member within 60 days (120 days for horse and market beef projects) prior to the fair are not eligible to compete in that project as an independent junior.

Record Book: All Independent Exhibitors must have project management records and proof of supervision available as to the length of the project. **Record books are due to the Tehama District Fair by June 9th**, **2025**, **before the exhibitor can receive their check**.

Picture and Hair Sample: Independent Exhibitors entering market animals <u>must provide</u> fair management with a picture of their animal, appropriate proof of ownership, permanent ear tag, tattoo and/or hog ear notch information 120 days prior for beef, 60 days for sheep, goats, and pigs, and 30 days for rabbit and poultry. Bring to Tehama District Fair, 650 Antelope Blvd, Red Bluff, CA 96080.

On Grounds Supervision: All Independent Exhibitors must participate in barn duty. All animals must be fed and watered in a timely manner. Animals not fed or watered in a timely manner will be excused from the fair. All Independent Exhibitors and adult supervisors must check in with the Livestock Office by 8 am daily during fair week.

Uniform: The "uniform" for independent exhibitors will be a white dress shirt or blouse (long or short sleeved), dark denim jeans/slacks (no fades, no rips), and closed toed footwear. No hats allowed.

Insurance Coverage: Exhibitors may purchase insurance through California Fair Services Authority. CFSA insurance may be purchased for the *entire family* by submitting a **cashier's check** or **money order** for the appropriate amount to the Tehama District Fair.
