

## **2025 Manatee County Fair**



### **12<sup>th</sup> Annual Hay Bale Decorating Contest**

The 2025 Hay Bale Decorating contest is open to all 4-H Clubs and FFA Chapters in Manatee County.

All entries should be made as a 4-H Club or FFA Chapter project.

4-H Clubs and FFA Chapters must be entered by Friday, December 27, 2024.

All entries must submit a sketch and/or diagram of decoration and theme. You should use the fair theme “Keeping Agriculture Alive in 2025” to decorate the bale.

The Manatee County Fair will provide one round bale for each participating Club to decorate.

Entries will be judged on eye appeal, construction, use of materials and creativity as well as the use of the fair theme “Keeping Agriculture Alive in 2025”.

**Hay bales will be placed around the fairgrounds by the committee. Hay bales may be decorated starting on Saturday, January 11, 2025, from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. All Hay Bale displays must be completed by Wednesday, January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 12 p.m. Entries will be judged Thursday morning January 16, 2025. The bales should be decorated with a good clean wholesome nature. No vulgar or suggestive decorations will be allowed—this includes people rolled up inside a bale with feet or head sticking out.**

Bales can be placed lying on their side or standing on end. This will be your choice. Please specify position of bale on entry form. Each club or chapter may provide a maximum of 8 small rectangular bales for feet or decoration. For safety purposes, round bales will not have other hay bales of any size stacked on top of them. Also, please note that decorated hay bales will be displayed on concrete or grass.

Paint may be applied to the hay bale or grass. NO paint will be applied to the concrete, if display is set up on concrete.

NO Commercial or Political party signs of ANY KIND are allowed.

**DECORATIONS SHOULD BE WEATHER AND WIND PROOF.**

**BALES SHOULD BE CHECKED  
THROUGHOUT THE FAIR WEEK BY A MEMBER OF YOUR CLUB TO  
MAKE SURE YOUR DISPLAY IS COMPLETE AND UNDAMAGED.  
ALSO, TO KEEP THE AREA AROUND YOUR BALE CLEAN AND FREE  
OF TRASH.**

**Decorations must be removed from bales on the last night of the fair, January 26<sup>th</sup>, after the Fair closes at 7 PM. Decorations not removed at that time may be discarded.**

Premiums will be issued to the top three Clubs or Chapters  
1st Place - \$500 2nd Place - \$400 3rd Place - \$300
