Open Class Rules (Tuff Trucks) 2025 Warren County Fair

Rules:

- 1. All participants and spectators must be at least 18 years of age. No passengers will be allowed.
- 2. Drivers must wear a helmet, eye protection and a seat belt during the race.
- 3. Drivers must remain inside their vehicle until they are notified by an official that it's safe to exit the vehicle.
- 4. No hot rodding in the pit area.
- 5. Doors must be shut securely at all times during the race. Any open door during the race will be cause for disqualification.
- 6. There is no alcohol or drugs allowed in the pit area. Any driver or pit crew caught with alcohol or drugs will be disqualified.
- 7. Front seats must be securely bolted to the floor with secure functioning seat belt.
- 8. Vehicles are required to have a working fire extinguisher inside the vehicle during the race.
- 9. Vehicles must have full front bumpers.
- 10. One fuel tank per vehicle. Mounted safe, secure, not leaking to the chassis. All others must be removed or have visible drain plugs removed, or have a visible hole drilled through it.
- 11. Trucks may have any modifications to the engine and driveline with the exception of Alcohol fuel. Gas or Diesel only for fuel.
- 12. Must have working brakes.
- 13. 2-ton trucks or larger, both single axle and tandem trucks
- 14. All batteries must be secured under the hood. If battery is relocated inside the cab, it must be secured to the floor and covered to protect the driver
- 15. Needs to have a complete wood or steel box the width of the axles. Must secure the box to the frame rails on both sides with chain to keep the box from moving
- 16. Split rims are not allowed.
- 17. Glass does not need to be removed
- 18. No large truck mirrors on the truck. Only 8" factory type or smaller round mirrors are allowed on the front fender or hood mounted
- 18. Truck numbers need to be legible and displayed on both truck doors.
- 19. Helmet, Long sleeves, pants, gloves required to compete
- 20. Officials decision is final
