# YOUTH OPEN BREEDING GOAT SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

### **PURPOSE:**

THE INTENT AND PURPOSE OF THE SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION YOUTH GOAT SHOW IS TO PROVIDE A MEANS TO PROMOTE THE ANIMAL INDUSTRY IN FLORIDA. FURTHERMORE, THIS IS AN EDUCATIONAL PROJECT FOR YOUTH. THIS SHOW PROVIDES YOUTH WITH A MEANS TO GAIN RECOGNITION FOR ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE DAIRY AND MEAT GOAT PROJECTS.

### **ELIGIBILITY:**

- 1. ONLY A BONA-FIDE 4-H OR FFA MEMBER, WHO IS AT LEAST 8 YEARS OF AGE AS OF SEPTEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup> AND IS ENROLLED IN A FLORIDA RECOGNIZED SCHOOL IS ELIGIBLE. YOUTH MUST NOT HAVE COMPLETED THE 12<sup>TH</sup> GRADE.
- 2. ANIMALS THAT CANNOT BE MANAGED PROPERLY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND WILL BE DISOUALIFIED.
- 3. NO BUCKS PERMITTED.
- 4. GOATS MUST BE IN SHOW SHAPE UPON ARRIVAL AT THE FAIR.

### **SCHEDULE:**

**DAIRY AND PYGMY GOAT** CHECK-IN IS FROM 7AM-9AM. ON SATURDAY MARCH 1, 2025. **MEAT GOAT** CHECK-IN IS FROM 10 A.M.-12 P.M. ON SATURDAY MARCH 1, 2025. THE GOAT SHOW WILL BEGIN AT 10:00 AM ON SATURDAY MARCH 1, 2025.

#### **ENTRIES:**

- 1. THERE WILL BE NO MAXIMUM NUMBER OF ENTRIES PER EXHIBITOR.
- 2. \$30.00 ENTRY FEE WITH A \$10.00 ENTRY FEE FOR SHOWMANSHIP.
- 3. USE A SEPARATE ENTRY FORM FOR EACH EXHIBITOR.
- 4. ALL INFORMATION AND SIGNATURES MUST BE COMPLETED ON ENTRY FORM.
- 5. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ON COMPLETED ONLINE AND MUST BE RECEIVED BY <u>FEBRUARY 26,</u> 2025, ALONG WITH ENTRY FEE TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SHOWMANSHIP.
- 6. ONLINE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AT CHECK-IN. HOWEVER, A \$50.00 LATE FEE WILL BE APPLIED. LATE FEE IS DUE IN CASH.
- 7. EACH ANIMAL ENTERED IN THE SHOW MUST HAVE THE CORRECT BIRTH DATE ON THEIR ENTRY FORM.
- 8. ANIMALS MUST BE SHOWN IN THEIR RESPECTIVE DIVISION AND CLASSES. EXHIBITOR THAT HAS BEEN INCORRECTLY ENTERED MAY, AT THE DISCRETION OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE, MAY BE TRANSFERRED TO THEIR PROPER DIVISION/CLASSES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE SHOW.

### **HEALTH REGULATIONS:**

- 1. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN OFFICIAL HEALTH CERTIFICATE, PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION AND FREE OF EVIDENCE OF DISEASE. THE OFFICIAL USDA SCRAPIE EAR TAG IS REQUIRED AND WILL BE INSPECTED UPON ARRIVAL.
- 2. THERE WILL BE NO VET CHECK AT THE SHOW.

# **ETHICAL TREATMENT:**

ALL ANIMALS MUST BE TREATED IN AN ETHICAL AND HUMANE MANNER. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE SHOWN IN THEIR NATURAL CONFORMATION AND STRUCTURE WITHOUT ALTERCATION. GROOMING, TREATMENT OF HAIR & TRIMMING OF THE HOOVES ARE ACCEPTED. ANY VIOLATION MAY RESULT IN THE DISQUALIFICATION OF THE ANIMAL AND THE EXHIBITOR.

#### **GENERAL:**

- 1. THE OWNER/EXHIBITOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CARE AND CLEAN-UP OF HIS/HER OWN ANIMALS. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE THEIR STALL/TRAILER AREA CLEAN BEFORE LEAVING THE GROUNDS. IN ORDER TO RECEIVE PREMIUM MONEY, THE STALLS OR TRAILER AREAS MUST BE CHECKED OUT BY THE SHOW CHAIRMAN.
- 2. DUE TO THE EXCESSIVE DEMAND ON THE ELECTRICAL OUTLETS, GENERATORS ARE WELCOME TO BE USED OUTSIDE.
- 3. EXHIBITORS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF THEIR ANIMAL UPON ENTERING THE FAIRGROUNDS.
- 4. ALL ANIMALS SHOULD BE RESTRICTED WITH A HALTER AND UNDER THE CONTROL OF THEIR EXHIBITOR BEFORE AND AFTER THE SHOW.
- 5. THE EXHIBITOR IS REQUIRED TO WEAR PANTS, COLLARED SHIRTS, CLOSED TOED SHOES.
- 6. ONLY ONE ENTRY ARMBAND FOR EXHIBITOR. PARENTS OR GUARDIANS WILL NOT RECEIVE A PASS. PASSES CAN BE PRE-PURCHASED DURING REGISTRATION, ONLINE AT SUMTERFAIR.NET, OR AT THE GATE AT THE TIME OF CHECK-IN. DAY PASSES FOR ADULT 12 & UP ARE \$10.00, KIDS 6-11 YEARS, SENIORS, & MILITARY ARE \$7.00. WEEKLONG PASSES ARE \$45.00, 5 AND UNDER ARE FREE.
- 7. SHAVINGS FOR THE STALLS ARE NOT PROVIDED. EXHIBITORS MUST BRING THEIR OWN SHAVINGS.
- 8. DISQUALIFIED EXHIBITORS AND/OR ANIMALS WILL NOT RECEIVE REFUNDS FOR ENTRIES OR PASSES.
- 9. EACH EXHIBITOR/OWNER ASSUMES ALL LIABILITY IN CASE OF DEATH OR INJURY TO HS/HER ANIMAL AND ANY INJURY, DAMAGE OR DEATH INCURRED BY HIS/HER ANIMAL. THE SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION AND OR ITS DIRECTORS WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY INJURY OR LOSS TO HUMAN, ANIMAL OR PERSONAL PROPERTY.

### **JUDGING:**

- 1. THE SHOW COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DIVIDE OR COMBINE CLASSES BASED ON THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES.
- 2. ALL PREMIUM MONIES WILL BE PAID TO THE EXHIBITOR DESIGNATED ON THE ENTRY FORM.
- 3. HORNED ANIMALS WILL BE ALLOWED PROVIDED THE GOAT IS NOT UNRULY OR ABUSIVE.
- 4. MEAT, DAIRY, AND PYGMY GOATS ARE IN THREE SEPARATE SHOWS AND SHALL NOT COMPETE AGAINST ONE ANOTHER. MEAT GOATS AND PYGMY GOATS WILL COMPETE IN THE SAME SHOWMANSHIP DIVISION.
- 5. A GOAT MAY NOT BE SHOWN IN MULTIPLE SHOWS.
- 6. NO BUCKS ALLOWED.
- 7. GOAT MUST BE SHOW GROOMED.
- 8. THE BEST OF SUMTER COUNTY CLASS ARE FOR SUMTER COUNTY EXHIBITORS ONLY. THE HIGHEST PLACING SUMTER COUNTY ANIMAL FROM EACH CLASS WILL COMPETE FOR THIS AWARD.
- 9. ALL ANIMALS WILL BE JUDGED USING THE DANISH SYSTEM AND WILL RECEIVE PREMIUMS.
- 10. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.

## SHOWMANSHIP: EXHIBITORS AGE AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2024

- 1. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST SHOW THEIR OWN ANIMAL. ANY EXHIBITOR FOUND SHOWING ANOTHER EXHIBITORS ANIMAL OR LOANING THEIR ANIMAL FOR SHOWMANSHIP WILL BE DISQUALIFIED AND THE PLACINGS/PREMIUMS WILL BE FORFEITED.
- 2. ALL SHOWMANSHIP ANIMALS MUST BE ENTERED IN A JUDGED CLASS.
- 3. SENIOR SHOWMANSHIP (14 & UP)
- 4. INTERMEDIATE SHOWMANSHIP (11-13)
- 5. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP (8-10)

THE SUMTER FAIR ASSOCIATION WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST OR DAMAGED PERSONAL ITEMS.
