2025 Tuff Truck SXS Rules

- 1. Registration for the event should be submitted prior to July 1, 2025.
- 2. Driver and 2 pit crew members must be at least 18 years old. All contestants and pit crew members must sign a waiver understanding that they are competing at their own risk and that they will not bring suit against any officials, employees, event sponsors
- 3. All vehicles must pass tech inspection before competing. If the officials determine a vehicle is unsafe, the officials have the right to not allow the vehicle to compete. The vehicle does not need a current license or insurance. The vehicle must be in the same physical condition as at the time it was last inspected by our Warren County track officials to compete. TECH INSPECTION AREA CLOSES ONE HOUR BEFORE COMPETITION IS SCHEDULED TO START.
- 4. A vehicle may be disqualified for either emotional or physical reasons by track officials. Example: Drugs or drinking alcoholic beverages. (Any driver or any of his or her pit crew consuming an intoxicating agent, and/or drugs, prior to or during the event will be disqualified from the event. Drivers will be held responsible for the actions of their crew). If any vehicle and/or driver is disqualified for any reason, no payout of prize winnings will occur for that competitor
- 5. Competitors must wait for the starting signal from the Starter Flagman before starting their runs. All competitors must stop immediately upon signal of the Red Flag displayed by any track official.
- 6. All contestants must drive the vehicle onto track and into position to compete under its own power and must leave track under its own power unless for breakage.
- 7. No one is allowed on the track except for track officials and contestants.
- 8. Fuel: Pump gas only. All forms of nitro are illegal as a fuel or additive.
- 9. Factory or upgraded seat harnesses are required and must be worn at all times while vehicle is in motion. No exceptions
- 10. Factory doors or nets are required and must remain latched at all times during the run.
- 11. Drivers must wear D.O.T. approved full-face helmet. Helmet strap must be fastened. Drivers must wear long pants and long sleeve shirts. No open footwear allowed.
- 12. No loose objects in the cab or any place else in the machine.
- 13. Must have stock height suspension, nothing bigger than a 31" tire, no wenches past the front or rear bumper,
- 14. Upgraded bumpers are ok as long as they are attached to the frame in the factory location.
- 15. Officials decision is final.
