Featured Artist:

Thomas Wargin, a sculptor from Wisconsin, has been selected as the Featured Artist for this year's festival by a panel of local art experts. With over 25 years of experience ranging from collaborations with Fortune 500 companies to intimate work in a small art studio, his career reflects a profound commitment to creating impactful, visually compelling works. His sculptures, often inspired by childhood stories and subconscious exploration, invite viewers to engage both their minds and visual senses.

His featured piece, *Balancing Boundaries*, explores the tension between freedom and constraint, harmony and discord. This theme is reflected in the contrasting materials he used --steel, stone, and bronze. The sculpture is a testament to Wargin's ability to blend metaphorical storytelling with masterful craftsmanship, leaving the audience with a sense of introspection and awe.

All proceeds from the festival go toward The Woodlands Arts Council's Student Art Scholarship and Microgrant programs and various other arts projects in Montgomery County.
