## **Open Show Rules and Regulations:**

- All entries must be pre-entered by August 2 at 5 PM, no walk in accepted.
- All entries must include full name, address, telephone number, and email of exhibitor, as well as animal name or tag/ID number by August 2.
- All entries are taken on a first come, first served basis, and must include the **\$10 per animal entry fee**.
- Exhibitors will receive three (3) admission tickets.
- All animals must be stalled in the designated barn.
- Only exhibitors, ring steward, superintendents and judges are allowed in the Show Ring.
- Open goat classes are to be judged strictly on conformation alone, and the decision of the judge is final.
- Animals cannot be removed from the grounds prior to published release times.
- All exhibitors must enter the livestock check in point off Dalton Ave.
- Entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- No animals will be allowed to unload if exhibiting signs of contagious disease, external parasites, ringworm, or abscesses. Any abscess site must be haired over.
- Breeding does and bucks will be shown by age and broken into classes based on entries received.
- Only Division 23A Showmanship classes are sanctioned through the 509 Show Circuit and North Idaho Junior Circuit!

# **Premiums and Special Awards**

**Grand Champion:** \$15 & rosette ribbon will be awarded to the top entry in each division.

**Reserve Champion:** \$10 & rosette ribbon will be awarded to the second top entry in each division.

**Best of Show:** A banner will be awarded to the overall best of show entry for Divisions A-E

1st place: \$9 & blue ribbon

2nd place: \$7 & red ribbon

3rd place: \$5 & white ribbon

#### ADGA Show Rules and Regulations:

- All entries must be pre-entered by August 2 at 5 PM, no walk in accepted. Any changes must be submitted by 5 PM on Wednesday, August 14, late fees may be applied.
- All entries are taken on a first come, first served basis, and must include the **\$7 per animal entry fee.**
- Exhibitors will receive three (3) admission tickets.
- All animals must be stalled in the designated barn
- Only exhibitors, ring steward, superintendents and judges are allowed in the Show Ring.
- The decision of the judge is final
- All animals must be stalled in the designated barn.
- Animals cannot be removed from the grounds prior to published release times.
- Competition is open to all breeds.
- Entry fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- All exhibitors must enter the livestock check in point off Dalton
- Registration papers need to be checked by Superintendent to show.
- Entry forms must list name and registration numbers of animals entered. All exhibitors and their helpers are required to carry the registration certificates for each animal into the show arena.
- All entries must include full name, address, and telephone number of exhibitor, as well as full registered name of animal.
- We would like to encourage all exhibitors to wear white while showing animals.
- Base date for age classes is the first date of show.
- All goats will be clinically inspected by authorized personal on entering fairgrounds. Goats with Caseous Lympohadentitis (CL), Caprine Arthritis Encephalities (CAE) or any other contagious or infectious diseases, animals exhibiting these symptoms will be asked to leave.
- All animals shown in group classes must have been shown in their regular individual age class. ANIMALS CANNOT CROSS DIVISIONS FOR GROUP CLASSES
- This is an official A.D.G.A. sanctioned show and their rules shall govern.
- AOP-all other purebreds include: Sannens, Sables, Toggenburgs, Guernseys.

#### **Premiums and Special Awards**

1st place: \$9 & blue ribbon 2nd place: \$7 & red ribbon 3rd place: \$5 & white ribbon Premiums will be awarded to entries placed 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> only; Grand and Reserve Champion as well as Breeds will receive ADGA awards.

- **41** Dairy Herd to consist of Four (4) Does in milk owned by the exhibitor. One (1) entry per exhibitor only.
