NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that finds the Quail Run Services, LLC Hobbs Wastewater Treatment Plant has met all the requirements said forth in Ordinance No. 83 and is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commission Chair and/or County Manager may finalize and sign any agreements consistent with the terms of this resolution.
