NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lea County that an increase from twenty (\$20) dollars to twenty-five (\$25) dollars per month for Longevity Incentive Pay for regular, full-time employees is hereby approved.
